rethren. Joyous Easter Greetings in the Name of Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!

This is the Blessed Season of Eastertide. The herald "Christ is Risen" rings afresh and aloud to the whole world! The joyous message of faith and hope for Christians is that Christ is Risen!

He is Risen indeed! Because He lives, we can face tomorrow! You and I have no idea how powerful this news must have been 2,000 years ago to a devastated community of followers of Jesus Christ. After Christ crucified. broken-hearted was Arimathea Joseph of secured

permission from Pilate to take away the Body of Jesus. Together with Nicodemus, they dutifully did the customary burial preparation and laid the Lord in a new burial tomb (John 19:38-42). They weren't expecting Christ's Resurrection.

The women, who lovingly and faithfully cared for Christ during His earthly ministry, rose up early that Easter morn and bought spices and ointment to anoint the Body of their beloved Lord (Mark 16:1-3). They, too, were not expecting the Lord's Resurrection and were bewildered to find the Tomb empty! Confusion, fear and tears flooded their hearts and minds all at the same time (Mark16:8). They were "falling apart" and completely astounded. And in this perplexed state, the women were told - "He (Christ) is Risen: He is not here... as He said" (16:6-7).

The Disciples, who saw how their dear Master and Lord was tortured and crucified like a criminal. utterly discouraged were and demoralized. Fearing for their own lives, they went into hiding. That Jesus would rise again from the dead - was not in their minds. When told by Mary Magdalene of the Empty Tomb, they guaked in disbelief and with a convulsion of emotions, they ran faster than ever to check it out (John 20:2-10). Uncertain of what had

happened and what to imagine, they then went home. That same evening, the Risen Christ appeared in their midst and invited them to confirm His Resurrection (John 20:20-21). Gladness filled the Disciples' hearts. Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed!

> The Glorious News of Christ's Resurrection went "viral" in God's Promised Land! Even the as Disciples were excited and energized by it, the enemies of Christ gathered quickly to attempt to disprove the Irrefutable Truth of the Resurrection of the Lord. They injected a diabolic

lie to dissolve (without success) the triumphant fact of the Resurrection, Brethren, God's Truth stands forever! The Resurrection survives till today and will stand forever more (Matthew 28:11-15).

The world either accepts the Resurrection of Jesus Christ and receives salvation by grace through faith in Christ, or it rejects it altogether, leading to a detrimental end. If Christ be not risen -- all mankind will remain in its helpless and hopeless state, awaiting a grim eternity. If Christ be not risen -- our faith is in vain (1 Cor 15:19). But thanks be to God for the Glorious Message of Easter -- Christ is Risen! A life having Christ as Saviour and Lord is a blessed life of hope, joy, liberation, motivation and rejuvenation. Eastertide calls us Christians not only to rejoice in, but also to declare the Blessed Hope of the Resurrection of our Lord and Saviour, to one and all.

Go, Tell... Christ is Risen Today! Hallelujah!

Rise, O Church, Come and worship Christ, the Risen King! Hallelujah! Rejoice, Christ is Risen! He is Risen indeed!
