Sermon outline (8 May 2022)

Title: How should we in the Lord respond to sickness and death?

Speaker: Ps Ben Tsao

Text: John 11:1-44

- 1. Recognize that those loved by Jesus are not exempt from sickness and death (vv 1-3, 5, 36)
- 2. Recognize that sickness or death can be a means to demonstrate God's glory (vs 4)
- 3. Let us trust that God's plan is always perfect even when we don't understand the situation (vv 5-6, 17, 21-23, 32, 37)
- 4. Recognize that the purpose of answered prayer/miracles is to point to Jesus (vs 15)
- 5. We must have faith in Jesus as the resurrection and the life (vv 24-32)
- 6. We can grieve with Jesus who empathizes and cares for us (vv 33-36, 1 Cor 15:26)
- 7. Recognize that Jesus has the power to raise the dead (vv 38-44)

REFLECTIONS ON GOD'S FAITHFULNESS

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 8 May 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
Yesterday was the graduation ceremony during which I was formally conferred my Master of Divinity degree.
Thank God for the past 3 years of experiencing His faithfulness in carrying me through my studies at Singapore Bible College which I started in July 2019. In particular, this last semester of January to April 2022 has been particularly heavy and stressful, but God's grace and strength have proved to be more than sufficient.

My initial step of faith: I was approached by Pastor Simon and the Board of Elders to prayerfully consider, together with my family, going for the 3-years Master of Divinity course at SBC starting in July 2019. The initial feeling of much doubt filled my heart. But after much encouragement and many weeks of seeking after the Lord's Will, my heart's conviction was that I should place my complete faith, trust, and dependence in the LORD to bring me through it. Even though I was not able to see the whole journey ahead, God spoke to me to take the initial step of faith, and He would further pave the way ahead for me.

Tough period of initial transition: the initial few months in SBC proved to be rather tough as some transitions and changes needed to be made in my daily schedule. In addition, I had to intentionally find time to catch up on the reading and other weekly assignments including the periods of traveling time from home to college to church. There were also late nights spent completing my schoolwork. But thanks to Pastor Simon and Dness May San and my collabourers in my ministry areas for their graciousness in taking up more so that I have

had more flexibility to cope with the load of my studies.

Two additional main areas of adjustment: notwithstanding the initial discomfort and stretching, 2 main happenings were added to them. First, is the onset of COVID-19 in early 2020 which ultimately forced the suspension of onsite classes at SBC and the switching to online classes via Zoom, and then to the past semester of alternate weeks of onsite and online classes. This brought on an exponential increase of time spent looking at the computer screen, and the onset of Zoom fatigue which added to the challenge of my studies.

Second, was the plan for another child but the unexpected timing of the birth of my daughter in May 2020 which is not only in the midst of my studies but also during the Circuit-Breaker phase of the COVID-19 situation right here in Singapore. Though unexpected, it was still in God's timing during my semester break from May to July 2020 during which we have had time to prepare for her impending birth, but also to move into our new home. Indeed, God provided me with the time and space to handle all the needed arrangements and adjustments.

Growth through challenging times: the entirety of my 3 years in SBC have not only been a theological and academic journey, but also one that has also refreshed and reinvigorated my sense of the importance of relating and journeying well with God in all seasons of life. As I move back more fully into church ministry life, I am committed to letting God lead and guide me so that I can, in the end, say as the Apostle Paul in 2 Tim. 4:7 "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith".
