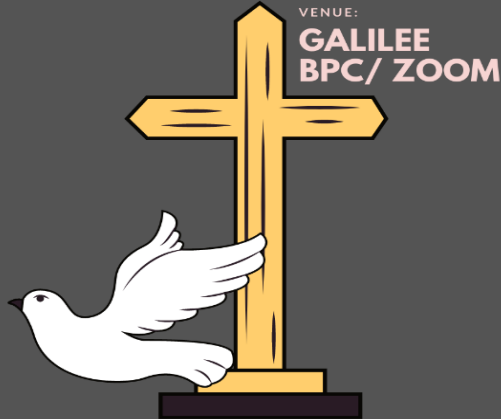

OUR MISSION ON EARTH

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 22 May 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Even as God has sent His Son Jesus Christ to this Earth as a human being to save us from our sins (John 3:16-17), we as His followers are sent into the world as His ambassadors and witnesses to save others too (John 20:21). As such, our lives should be a reflection of the glory of God shining forth as salt and light amid the uncertainties and struggles in this fallen world (Matt. 5:13-16), and not conforming to the principles and patterns of this world (Romans 12:1-2).

Our mission with God's Word: The starting point of being on mission for God on Earth is to develop the heart for Him and His spiritual things through our learning and enriching from His Word. We should not view familiar Bible stories and accounts as nothing new for us to think through and apply them into our lives. Instead, we should always have an inquisitive attitude as what the Pharisee Nicodemus had in his interaction with Jesus (John 3:4, 9), allowing the Holy Spirit to reveal and illuminate new and refreshing insights from God's Word. For the next month from June 9 to 11, we would have our Galilee Bible Retreat. May it be a sparking point from which our interest and commitment to God's Word can be rekindled and refreshed.

God's Word fueling our mission for Him: As we allow God's Word to do its work in our lives, we would in turn faithfully obey and keep to it (John 3:11 "Truly, truly, I say to you, we speak of what we know and testify of what we have seen, and you do not accept our testimony"). Our faithful obedience to God's Word is not only in seasons of God's glorious blessings (John 1:12-13), but also that of difficulties, hardships, and persecution

(Gal. 2:20 "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me"). As Dietrich Bonhoeffer once said, "Who can really be faithful in great things if he has not learned to be faithful in the things of daily life?"

Our mission for God: we should be forming our earthly identity from the reality that we are children of God, even overshadowing our work, studies, family, personal goals and ambitions, life experiences and struggles (Phil. 3:18-20 "For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things. For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ"). We must seek to know what God's mission is for each of us, and to then be actively fulfilling it regardless of the cost of doing so. Charles Swindoll says, "Whatever we do, we must not treat the Great Commission like it's the Great Suggestion."

May our lives have more impact for God's kingdom than the mere length of our lives. Let us draw our motivation and inspiration from people such as Jim Elliot (29 years old) and 5 of his peers who died at the hands of the Auca Indians in Ecuador but planted the seeds of the Gospel of love in their hearts, Eric Liddell (1902-1945) best known because of the 1981 film Chariots of Fire which featured his life, especially as an Olympic runner, died at age 43; and Keith Green (1953-1982), the well-known musician, songwriter and evangelist who impacted so many in his short life, died at age 28.
