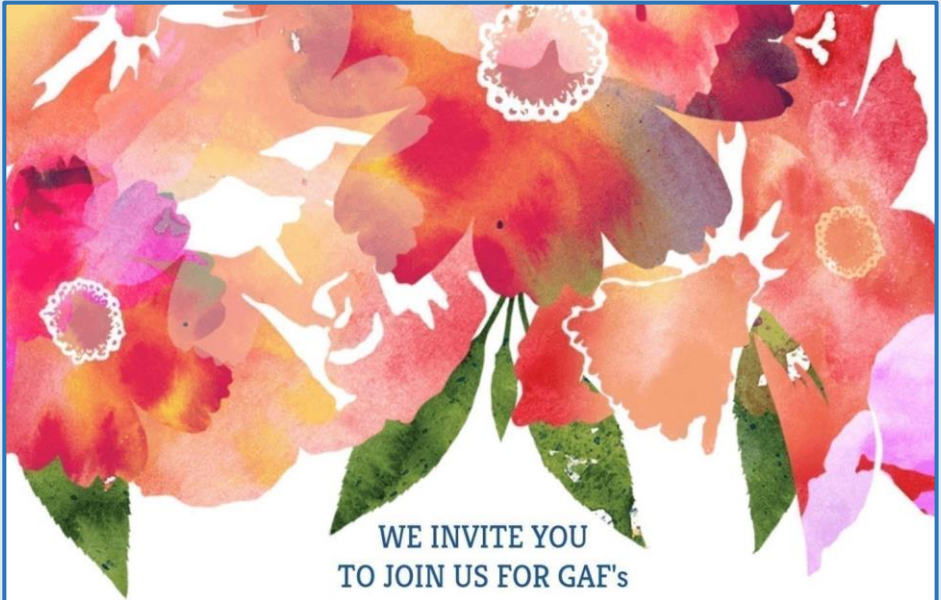

# GOD'S WORD IN COMMUNITY

*Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 12 June 2022*

**B**eloved Brethren,  
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Thank God for a blessed Church Bible Retreat from 9-11 June. Let us be reminded of the importance and centrality of God's Word in our lives. Ps. 1:1-2 says, "Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the Law of the Lord, and in His Law doth he meditates day and night."

**The Blessedness in God's Word:** When our hearts are focused on God's Word, we will surely experience the following four areas of blessedness mentioned in verse 3 and the parallel verse from Jeremiah 17:8.

First, we will be **planted by the rivers of water**. Being planted means that our roots have grown deep into the soil and draw our spiritual nourishment and strength. When we are rooted in Christ (Col. 2:6-7), we will remain firm and steady even amid the storms of doubts and trying circumstances in our lives. Our faith ultimately must be placed on Christ instead of the things of this world.

Second, we will be found **fruitful for the Kingdom of God in every season of life**. Even as we go through the dry times in our lives, we can overcome the danger of discouragement by strengthening our hearts with the eternal promises in His Word. For our faith to remain ever-growing, healthy, and vibrant, we must remain connected to Christ (John 15:5). We are given the wonderful description of a person who has constant and continual faith in Christ, the leaf remaining green and not withering or drying

away even amidst intense adverse life circumstances.

Going back to Ps. 1:2, "But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in his law doth he meditate day and night" reminds us that we need **the continual knowledge and guidance from God's Word for us to know and do His Will**. When we read the word "prosper" or "success" in verse 3, we must train our minds not to think of physical or material things immediately. Instead, we should be prosperous and successful in persevering and keeping to God's Will. Even when we experience earthly failure and setbacks, they are still an essential part of our Heavenly Father's shaping process (Romans 8:28).

**The Blessedness of God's Community:** Not only have we been fed with God's Word during our Church Bible Retreat, but we also experienced a fruitful time of fellowshiping with one another through the post-message discussion and the different SSG afternoon activities. Such physical and spiritual togetherness indeed reminds us of this year's Church Theme Verse in Ps. 133:1 "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!"

It is also a timely reminder that we are not to think that we are strong and sufficient to go through life and our struggles on our own. As such, we must humbly walk with God as well as other people in the church family. We are to help one another, especially during our times of failure and difficulties (Eccl. 4:9-12) so that we in Galilee Church are a picture of everyone walking together in strong unity (Phil. 1:27).
