

## "THE LORD GOES BEFORE THEE... FEAR NOT"

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 5 June 2022

Anniversary greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! On this joyous occasion, we glorify our Lord for His goodness expressed to us through His faithfulness, unlimited grace, and boundless mercies. We journeyed through the COVID wilderness shrouded with the unknown, tiresome climbs and descends complex challenges and fast-evolving changes. It is a miracle how we have stayed together as a church, functioned in unity, persevered with tenacity, and arrived victoriously through the Almighty's Help and guidance as one people in the Lord.

Though the pandemic somewhat is behind us. The church's mission to the lost world remains integral. The Gospel is the hope to humanity that struggles in a complicated political matrix, social unrest, financial upheavals, and climatical threads. How can Galilee play a significant role where the Lord has planted us? Do we have the necessary resources, knowledge, and foresight to engage our opportunities accurately? The answer to that question is in the Lord's promise: "And the Lord, He it is that doth go before thee; He will be with thee, He will not fail thee, neither forsake thee: fear not, neither be dismayed" Deut 31:8.

God's Promise—I recall the days before the GPS era. When driving up Malaysia for Church Camp, we always check out who knows the way so that the rest of the convoy will proceed confidently to the camp venue. God's Word assures us that the Lord will lead us through the thick and thin, ups and downs, as we journey into the future. Our Lord knows the way. He goes before us; we stay right behind Him.

Sometimes, due to lack of concentration, or distraction, we lose sight of the lead car. Soon, we find ourselves in a dilemma. Where did the lead vehicle go to the left, right, or straight? Sometimes, we guess wrong. Consequently, suffer emotional distress and the loss of valuable time. How can this happen in the Lord's work?

The first temptation is to trust ourselves, where one's knowledge, experience, and past achievements give us the confidence to map out the future and the destiny (James 4:13-14). God's Word reminds us, "He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered" Prov 28:26.

Next, God's Word highlights that "Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the Name of the LORD our God." Ps 20:7. Our blessings in the form of chariots and horses sometimes translate into obstacles. When we marvel at our past glories, we quickly remember in all humility that they were God's gracious gifts to us. We are only permitted to boast in the Lord (1 Cor 1:31). Never find our confidence in our powerful allies, wealth, resources, and influential connections. Only Jesus, always Jesus! Let's keep our eyes on the Lord to avoid the loss of opportunities and blessings.
