THE COMMUNITY OF BELIEVERS

Pastor Simon N, Lord's Day, 19 June 2022

Brethren,
Greetings in the Lord, and Happy Father's Day!

Then or now, churches were not perfect. Why? Simply because the church is not a building of lifeless bricks, wood, steel and glass. The church is composed of imperfect people with "feet of clay", but all praise to God, He graciously redeemed us through Christ Jesus and received us into His fold and fellowship. Though we are perfect and righteous in Christ, we struggle with our sinful nature in this earthly life. And despite our shortcomings, God has deliberately put us together in one body of believers to serve Him faithfully and grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord as one unified people in Christ Jesus. The church is not perfect because we are not perfect. But praise God that we are an **imperfect people loved by a Perfect God**, Who gave His Beloved Son to die for our sins at Calvary. And daily, He guides us to do His Perfect Will as we submit to Him.

The Book of Acts chapters 1 & 2 tells us why the Early Church, imperfect as it was, was still incredibly blessed by our Good and Perfect God, and for good reasons:

The Early Church was a praying church.

The people "all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication" (Acts 1:14). Everyone was present for the prayer meeting. The people were committed to praying. Imagine how our church will be if Galileans attend Wednesday Online Prayer Meeting regularly and come early for Sunday Pre-worship Prayer Meeting. The Lord will surely pour out His favour upon Galilee, as He did the Early Church. Brethren, come to pray as one household of faith. Our Lord declared: "My House shall be called the House of prayer..." (Matt 21:13). May Galilee Church always be a House of Prayer!

The Early Church was a united church.

"All continued with one accord" (Acts 2:1). The people came before God united in love and purpose, with a shared sense of need and mutual support. Brethren, unity is fundamental for the church's spiritual well-being. The devil always seeks to divide and diffuse the church's solidarity as we allow ourselves to be

driven by ego, pride and a self-serving agenda. Any misgivings, qualms, or issues, seek clarification, defuse doubts, and dismiss distrust, to secure unity among us, which is essential for our church's progress.

The Early Church was a witnessing church.

"They all began to speak" (Acts 2:4; 4:31). In the New Testament Church, believers were active in evangelism. The Scripture does not say that only the Apostles and the church leaders began to speak but that every member witnessed for Christ at every God-given opportunity. Let us share the Gospel boldly as the Holy Spirit empowers us to reach out to the unsaved. Let us individually and as a church witness and win souls for Christ, trusting God to give the increase (1 Cor 3:6).

The climax of Pentecost is recorded in Acts 2:14. The Apostle Peter stood up with the Eleven, lifted up his voice and preached the Gospel boldly. The Holy Spirit chose Peter to preach the sermon on that great day. Peter preached Christ. He preached with eloquence. He preached with conviction. He preached with boldness. He preached with power. He made definite demands of the people. He presented the claims of the Risen Christ. He called people to repentance. He commanded believers to be baptized. He extended an evangelistic invitation. And how the Lord blessed the church as thousands responded! (Acts 2:41). Even today, brethren, God honours faithful, Spirit-filled, Christ-centred preaching of His Word. Please uphold in prayer the preaching and teaching ministry in our church. Thank you for your prayers!

When a church dedicates its life to fervent, faithful, unceasing prayer, God will bless that church and do mighty works for His glory. The church that prays together stays together. Next, people, empowered by the Holy Spirit, witness boldly for Christ, and the Lord will add to our community men and women, young and old, through the miracles of conversion. Lastly, may the Lord provides pastors and preachers who will proclaim the Living Word faithfully and diligently without hesitation. Let's stay together and work together as one people in Christ Jesus!
