

HASTENING IN THE LORD'S WORK

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 26 June 2022

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Thank God for sustaining and leading my family through our recent struggles with COVID19 infection to recovery. In the same breath, I thank God for blessing me and my family with relatively good health so that I could focus on the last leg of my studies at Singapore Bible College as well as during our church's recent Bible Retreat.

Each of us should ask ourselves whether, during our good times, we focused more on pursuing and fulfilling our ambitions and goals instead of putting our whole-hearted focus and effort into developing our walk and heartfelt service and work for God.

In John 9:4, Jesus said, "[he] must work the works of Him that sent [Him], while it is day: the night cometh when no man can work". What Jesus has said about the characteristics of his earthly ministry in this very same verse of John 9:4, we can learn and apply these same important principles toward our acts of work or service for God.

First, the word "must" in John 9:4 reminds us that it is not a mere option that we can choose to exercise or not. Instead, we must view it as necessary to serve God with all of our time, gifts, and talents out of our love for Him. Thus, we must strive to serve God and not seek every possible excuse not to do so.

Second, when we look at the phrase "work the works...", its true sense would not only indicate the mere going through the physical actions of serving but also includes putting the entire being of our thoughts and actions into it. This means

we should approach our serving with enthusiasm and passion. We are further reminded when the phrase continues to describe that our works are of or given by God to whom we are undoubtedly accountable for how we performe or carry them out.

Third, when Jesus mentioned that he must complete God's works while it is day and not yet night, he was fully aware that his physical time on Earth is only a while limited by the Cross and His ascension back to Heaven. As such. He needed to use the time and opportunities before him fully. This same truth is also set before us: we must see every opportunity as God-given, that He has opened the door for us to serve Him and not let it pass by us. Time and the season of life are two things that can quickly pass us by. We are all unsure of our length of life on Earth. A good and smooth-going season can also promptly give way to another season that sees difficulties or distractions, impeding our total commitment and capacity to serve. It is also true that when we are not serving God in our good times, how then can we persevere and persist in serving Him when things get rough and tough in our lives?

Let us thus hasten and not delay to surrender our lives to be used by God. We must also not let our love for the things of this world, even so-called neutral or amoral things such as our family, career, or studies, distract and take away our time, focus, and energies for God and His kingdom purposes (Matt. 6:24; 1 John 2:15-17). Let us follow the personal, passionate, and daily commitment that Joshua had to serve God in Joshua 24:15 "...as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord", and keep our love for Him burning ever brightly (Rev. 2:4).
