# Galilee Sunday School 62<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 3 July 2022

Greetings in the glorious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Praise and thank God for His blessings upon our Sunday School for over half a century. The Lord is faithful and good!

In the past, many Galileans served faithfully as Sunday school superintendents, pianists, teachers, administrators, and helpers. Consequently, many young boys and girls were formed in their faith and knowledge of God's Word. We pray they will remain faithful to Christ Jesus and extend God's Kingdom.

Today, the Sunday school is experiencing difficult times. Our young people are fiercely taxed by various factors that thin their interest in studying God's Word. Hence, attendance falls. With the student population reduced, teachers are finding it hard to hold a class of reasonable size. This same condition discourages the few who are keen on regular classroom teaching. The cyclical effect is a grave concern for the Sunday School departments. To further add to this disheartening state, the reduced number in the Sunday School may not enable us to hold our traditionally held Annual Sunday School camp this year. Brethren, what can we do to rejuvenate the Sunday School ministry?

Firstly, we need to pray! The Psalmist says, "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear..." Ps 46:1-2. Brethren, may all of us commit some time to pray our Galilee Sunday School weekly.

Next, I encourage parents in our church to revisit and reinstate priority for our children's spiritual education. As much as we monitor closely and readily invest anything necessary for our children's progress in their secular education, we need a conscientious and concerted effort for their education in God's Word. These days, with modern gadgets, our young people don't have enough time to keep up with their myriad activities. After spending loads of time in school, their afterschool assignments like homework, projects, class tests, and tuition drain them dry. Moreover, they need time for family, friends, and their interests and pursuits. Under these pressures, it is unsurprising that studying the Bible slips way down the list of priorities.

What about parents? They face an uphill task. Holy Scriptures remind us of our sacred duty to teach and pass the baton of our faith to our next generation -- "Thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up" (Deut 6:7). "Teach them thy sons, and thy sons' sons; ..." (Deut 4:9). The paramount duty of Christian parents is to catechise our children at home in the Word of God and nurture them in the Most Holy Faith. But parents are not less busy with work and other struggles of life. Our adult Sunday school has also fallen in attendance. It looks like no one is spared. Dear parents, amidst various challenges, let us take seriously our God-given privilege and rightful place to "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it" Prov 22:6. We, ourselves, need to continue to grow in the Word through the various ministries in our church. Let us set the priority for spiritual importance to the next generation by word and by works. May God continue to pour His richest blessings upon our Sunday School Ministry. Blessed Galilee Sunday School Anniversary! To God be the glory!
