THE LORD'S MISSION AND US

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 10 July 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Our Lord has commissioned us with the responsibility to evangelise the locals and bring the Gospel to foreign soils (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 1:8).

Even when we cannot become missionaries or go on short-term mission trips to foreign lands, we may consider providing financial support and other relevant resources for others to go and support them fervently in prayer.

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, we have not been able to plan for and organise such mission trips. That has pushed us to think of creative and innovative ways to how we can connect with our foreign mission stations and partners, such as conducting camps and training using online platforms. In addition, this can mean that we can then put more resources and effort into our local evangelistic efforts to reach the community around our church and our unsaved loved ones and relatives.

Even before the onset of COVID-19 till now, Singapore is a globally connected country and has allowed people of different nationalities and different employment and skill sets to come in. This has given rise to the concept of "reverse missions", for which we can still reach people from other countries without going to their homeland. When this happens, we have opportunities to especially reach people who normally would have very limited and even possibly no opportunities and contact points with Christians and the proper understanding of the Gospel. Let us, knowing this, not shirk away from our Gospel responsibility but be always prepared

to reach out to others of different nationalities and ethnicities and to bring them into the bigger picture of the global Church (Gal. 3:28; Rev. 7:9).

Regardless, we still thank God that He has provided us with the means to restart our mission trips to Vietnam and Kenya. We thank God for His people in these 2 teams who are prepared to give their time, and effort and face a certain degree of risk in going to a foreign land even during this ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Let us commit all of them into the LORD's Hand to keep them safe while they set forth to do His Work and complete the mission before them.

I strongly urge each of us to be involved in the mission work that God has set specifically for us, local or overseas. We may think getting involved in such mission work will bring us various challenges and hardships, but let us be encouraged with the sure knowledge that God is ever-present with us as we endeavour to do His Work (Matt. 28:18-20; Acts 1:8). The Israelites certainly experienced God's Presence in the pillar of cloud by day, and the pillar of fire by night (Ex. 13:21-22). Similarly, we are reminded that God is faithful, and He will surely not leave us nor forsake us (Deut. 31:6; Joshua 1:5; Heb. 13:5). We are also divinely enabled and empowered by the Holy Spirit to do God's Work (Zech. 4:6).

Charles Swindoll says, "Whatever we do, we must not treat the Great Commission like it's the Great Suggestion." Let us courageously live out the Great Commission even amidst the atmosphere of fear, pressing forward with courage and taking risks in doing so.
