

"MAKING CHOICES"

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 17 July 2022.

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and
Saviour, Jesus Christ! Life has its defining
moments and critical crossroads along the way.
There are times without many choices given we
decide our direction. In challenging times especially,
how do we know we are making the right choice and
getting on the right path?

Believers, the only right way to go is the way of the Lord. When we stand at the crossroads of life, we must first seek God and be guided by His Word. The

Bible is the store house of invaluable insight and wisdom. It contains the whole counsel of God, applicable for all situations in life. Driving at night, on a dark rural road with the headlights off could be disastrous. Likewise, living life without the blessed illumination of the Word of God. "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path" (Ps 119:105). Making life choices without God's guidance has dire consequences.

Many things in life aren't 100% guaranteed; however, if we chart a path that is not in line with the Word, we are "courting" trouble. God's Word reveals God's Will!

But what happens if we don't seem to be able to find a direct answer from the Bible to help us in deciding? For instance, when faced with a decision to buy or rent a house, will we find a "thou shalt not rent, thou shalt buy" in the Bible? Probably not! So, what then can we do? God invites us to prayer.
