When we scan the global political situation in various countries, we would rightfully be thankful to God for the political stability and social and religious harmony we experience in our Island-City state. Nations with glorious pasts suffering from political instability, unemployment, corruption, ravages of war, and government with incapable leaders. Yet, we live and breathe in one of the wealthiest nations in the world. We praise and thank God for His goodness!

powers. We are constantly under some authority on earth and to God. Our homes, workplaces, sports, airports, parks, roads, rails etc. We cannot do things as we like! No one spared from coming under authority. Paul said, "Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God." Rom 13:1. In this simple yet profound verse, the apostle mentioned the word "power" three times. The source of all power is God. The authority behind all authorities is God Himself.
