

#### IN ALL THINGS

Pastor Simon N., Lord's Day, 21 August 2022

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ. Have you had a bad
day, and were you able to gather some
legitimacy to thank God? Not easy, right? What
comes forth quickly and naturally is murmur and
complaint. We have had such moments where we
are not so keen to visit in our minds.

A man once stole Matthew Henry's wallet, a renowned Bible commentator. Henry reflected on the incident, "I am thankful that he never robbed me before. Next, I am thankful that although he took my wallet, he did not take my life. Next, although he took all I had, it was not much. Last, I am glad that I was robbed, not I who did the robbing." Yes, it may sound unnatural to a simple and ordinary Christian. Yet, Henry's outlook accounts for his spiritual maturity and relationship with God.

The Apostle Paul encourages the Thessalonian Christians: "in everything give thanks: for this is the Will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (1Thess 5:18). Everything, yes, in Everything without exception. The Christians in Thessalonica were facing persecution for their faith. Christians' properties were taken against their will; people in business could not continue their trades peacefully: some suffered ostracism, verbal abuse, and physical harm was not uncommon; some even died for their faith. In such a turbulent atmosphere, the apostle calls on Christians to be always thankful to God. In other words, in any situation, there is always a praiseworthy element worthy of praise. Ruth Bell Graham well said, "We can't always give thanks FOR everything, but we can always give thanks IN everything."

Surely, it is easy to be thankful when things are going our way, but when it becomes complex, complicated, and catastrophic, it is tough. However, we Galileans can rise above adversity because we wholeheartedly trust in a loving, gracious, and

merciful God who will lead us through any predicament (Ps 23:4).

If we recall how Job conducted himself in the face of extreme hardship, we realise we, by God's grace, could also praise and worship God uninterrupted by circumstances. He said, "Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away; blessed be the Name of the Lord" Job 1:21.

Next, Paul highlights that this is not his will but God's. God desires our praises in all seasons of our lives. When praising God in "dark times," we express our complete trust and unwavering faith in Him. We are not fair-weather Christian who abandon the faith conveniently when faced with headwinds in life. Instead, we embossed in our hearts Paul's motto: "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain" Phil 1:29.

Brethren, we have been through the valley season, and we can expect such trying times to return where disappointment, hindrances, and frustration will all play together to make life's dreadful moments. Yet, in adversity, our faith is forged. God's Word and His promises will see us through again and again. Our Lord will give us extraordinary strength and tenacity to be steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord..." 1 Cor 15:58. Praise the Lord!

God wants us to be always grateful to Him since "we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose." Rom 8:28.

Give thanks with a grateful heart!
Give thanks to the Holy One.
Give thanks, give thanks!
Blessed be His Holy Name!
