FINDING REST IN GOD

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 14 August 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We in Singapore live in a fast-moving society. What this means is that we get caught up in our daily activities -- working, studying, having family time, serving the Lord in church. As a result, we often find ourselves overwhelmed and stressed, and have no time to quieten ourselves and have proper rest.

Physical tiredness is often a sign that our bodies need their much-needed rest. Spiritual lethargy is a sign that our souls are getting worn out. As physical rest is needed for physical tiredness, spiritual rest in God is surely needed to soothe our weary souls. Listen to our Lord's loving invitation: (Matt. 11:28 "Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest"). St. Augustine of Hippo prayed and sought rest in God: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you." A good prayer for us too.

So how does true rest look like in our lives? Let's understand that the Biblical concept of "rest" is more than mere physical rest, and is very closely linked to having the inner peace of God in our hearts (Phil. 4:7 "And **the peace of God**, which passeth all understanding, **shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus**"). The peace of God is not just an external peaceful disposition, but that which comes forth from our hearts and minds when we are focused on God.

This inner rest and peace is also not just a mere one-time state or condition, but it should also be a continuous and ongoing process throughout our lives. We need to continually seek to cultivate this inner rest and peace. Phil. 4:6 "Be

careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God" -- tells us that spending time in communion with God through prayer is one way to do so. We can also meditate on God's Word, and seek rest together with God's people. All these spiritual disciplines will keep our hearts and minds focused on, and in tune with God.

When we have the inner peace from God in our hearts, it will enable us to see our external circumstances correctly from Heavenly perspectives, and not get frustrated and discouraged by our earthly human perspectives. Isaiah 40:31 "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint" -- reminds us that we can always have the joy and strength from God to shine for Him amid all life's circumstances and situations that come our way.

Heb. 12:2 urges us to put aside every weight and the sin in our lives so that we can walk well with God. This "every weight" is not necessarily sinful. It could refer to something neutral such as the demands of our family, our work or career, studies, and our relationships or friendships that can hinder or stumble us from fulfilling God's Will in our lives. The phrase "the sin" tells us not of the danger of sin in general, but it is the specific sins we harbour and allow to perpetuate that will stunt our spiritual effectiveness for God.

Brethren, let us slow the pace in our hectic schedules, and make time and space to find the perfect rest in God. Let's offer our lives as living sacrifices, pleasing and acceptable to God, and we will not burn out easily in our passion and zeal in service for Him. Amen.
