



### PRESSING ON IN THE LORD'S SERVICE

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 28 August 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ. Thank God for
enabling and giving the Vietnam Mission
Team the blessed opportunity to serve and minister
to the children at the Mustard Seed Academy
Summer Camp in Hanoi from 1-5 August 2022. I
believe that all who went on this Vietnam Mission
Trip were not prepared for the sudden and lastminute changes. However, we were all willing and
empowered by the Holy Spirit to adjust our
expectations as we doubled our efforts and
energies for the Children's Camp.

This gives us the valuable principle that in planning and carrying out our ministry programmes and activities, we must have a mindset prepared to accept and respond to unexpected and sudden changes. The Holy Spirit may re-direct our paths and goals such that we are given new directions-to accomplish His purpose for His praise and glory. This was what the Apostle Paul faced in Acts 16:6-12, as he desired strongly to go to Bithynia. Instead, the Holy Spirit did not allow him to go there but directed him to go to Macedonia. Paul did not resist this new direction but was willing to go as the Lord led him. Similarly, when we are faced with a new direction from God, we must remain completely trusting in Him and surrender to His direction.

At the same time, we must still maintain our confidence and assurance in God to press forward to do our best with the changes. (Phil. 2:13 "For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure"). We would then be able to put our whole heart into it "without murmurings and disputings" (Phil. 2:14). We must always be prepared for the different lessons, through both "good" and "bad" things, that God has in store for us to learn. It is only when we have this important learning and teachable attitude that God can grow and strengthen our faith in Him (1 Peter 1:7 "That

the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ").

1 Tim 1:12 "And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful. putting me into the ministry" reminds us that we need to remain always thankful that God sees us fit to call us into His Work and Service. Let us remain strong and faithful, and stay on-track where God has called us. keeping true to His Work and Service Nο matter what difficulties discouragements we encounter, we ought to keep our eyes on Jesus to keep us going for Him. It is our attitude in serving God that brings Him praise (Romans 12:1 "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ve present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service").

Let us strive to do greater things for God, and live a rich and fulfilling life for God (John 10:10). In seeking to do our best for God, we would view the different things in our lives not from our earthly perspective, but from God's heavenly perspective. We would then be increasingly able to rise above the circumstances and problems in our lives, seeing them as God working through them to fulfil His greater good. This process of striving to do greater things for God never stops, and its effects are seen in our lives through our worship and our service for Him.

May all of us press on in our work for God, knowing that we are all doing a spiritual work that would surely bear spiritual fruits in the lives of people according to His Will and Timing (1 Cor. 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord").
