

"BLESSED BE THE LORD"

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 4 September 2022

Prethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Saviour and
Lord Jesus Christ.

Lately, some in our midst were taken unexpectedly into a difficult and uncertain situation. We are upholding them constantly in prayer. My conversation with them was encouraging when I hear how they are persevering through their predicament with courage and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. These Galileans' fortitude in Christ will motivate others in our community to face headwinds with confidence and courage in Jesus.

King David wrote in Psalm 144:1, "Blessed be the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, and my fingers to fight:" David began his Psalm with praise - "Praise be the Lord." This amiable attitude of David. Paul encapsulated in his instruction to the Thessalonians—"In everything give thanks..." 1 Thess 5:18. We are familiar with David's "roller coaster" life. His brothers took him for granted; his national achievement turned against him, his father-inlaw fiercely sought to kill him, his first wife was given away, from royalty he declined to destitute. from palatial residence to cave-dwelling, from royal companionship to bands of vagabonds, plus, the constant presence of anguish, agony, anxiety and uncertainty. It was a period of misery in David's life.

However, amazingly, his lips were never too weary to come together in praise of the Almighty God. In this Psalm, David garlands the Lord with a beautiful description of who God is in his life—He is a rock, a giver of strength, a loving ally, a fortress, a tower of safety, a deliverer, a shield, a refuge, and a subduer. These are not mere ornamental titles given to the Lord; He is a God of action.

When we introduce a person as Olympic gold

medallist, it is not just a title or status; it is a recognition given in admiration of the individual's impressive performance and achievement. Likewise, we read action-words describing how God parts the heavens, reaches down, touches the mountains, releases the lightning bolts, rescues His people(Ps 144:5-7). Our God is a God of action. He does not only talk, but He demonstrates as well.

Brethren, in our various challenges, haven't we found the Lord to be the same as David's? Though troubles and trials in any area of our lives are unwanted, we must face them but thankfully not alone. The Lord is with us. He journeys with us like no other. Our Lord is not a bystander, just watching and sympathising with our situation. He participates in our difficult moments.

He orchestrates the timing, place, people, and resources to alleviate the hardship that comes upon us. We often marvel at how God has prearranged the situation according to His perfect knowledge, wisdom, and will bring about His plan in our lives (Jere 29:11). Nothing happens to us by chance or accident but by His sovereign will.

David, a warrior himself, says, "God taught his hands to war and fingers to fight." David had fought numerous battles in his life, especially with the Philistines. Surely, in these battles, he recalls how he defeated his tough opponents amidst various conditions in close combat. God gave him the upper hand to do war skilfully to achieve victory. In our lives, as we battle with life challenges, the Lord will train and build us adequately for each challenge to His glory.

Overwhelmed by God's goodness, David concludes the Psalm exhorting the people of God— "...yea, happy is that people, whose God is the Lord." Amen.
