SET THEE TO BE LIGHT

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 2 Oct 2022

Brethren, greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. In Acts 13:47, Paul describes his ministry with the words of the Prophet Isaiah, "For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth." (Is 49:6). God chose Israel to bring the Good News of salvation to all nations. But, then and now, the challenges are tall! Besides impeding personal circumstances, the god of this world blinded the minds [2 Cor 4:4] and darkened the hearts of humanity, preventing their liberation from dark spiritual bondage through the Gospel.

As children of light (1 Thess 5:5), God has appointed us to be the light in the community we live and work in. First, our position as "children of light. We did not come with this light, nor developed this light by our effort. The truth is, we were utterly engulfed in spiritual darkness. One could not pull oneself out of one's spiritual darkness through some measure of effort. Everyone is helpless (Rom 5:6). Until Christ came into our lives, redeeming us from sin and changing our earthly and heavenly perspectives. Since, He is the true light of the world (John 8:12); hence, we became children of light.

Next, we are called to shine for Jesus. Jesus said, "Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." Matt 5:14-16. God has called us to consistently shine in this dark world shrouded in sin, corruption, death, and decay. With Christ enabling us, we shine for Jesus in everything we do, and everywhere we go as His witnesses.

Brethren, thank God for the opportunity to shine for Jesus with the brethren in the Ebenezer community. After a two-year wait, a team of five finally made the trip to Kenya on 15 Sept. Our key concern was COVID-19 infection. Praise God we were kept safe and well. "God is good and His mercies endureth forever" Ps 136:1.

Our Lord kept the team in good spirit and health to do our specific assignments. At Ebenezer Family Camp, Dness Lee May San taught the children and youths, assisted by Bro Nathaniel Musyoki. As assigned, I taught the adult congregation the Beatitudes from the Gospel of Matthew. Sis Jenny Musyoki took the afternoon session on the 7 Churches from the Book of Revelation. During the afternoons, I joined the ordination council in preparing and interviewing the four candidates for ordination. Praise and thank God that the first Ebenezer ordination exercise went very well. All four preachers and pastors were ordained last Friday. It was a joyous occasion where two hundred children and adults came together. A dozen churches and pastors from various churches were present on this occasion. The celebration concluded with a bountiful feast where families, church members, friends, and relatives sat in groups under the trees and fellowship into the late afternoon.

Dness Jeannie Yeo managed the funds, took photographs, and prepared meals for the team and every other administrative concern. Then on the Lord's days, at Kavingoni and Ngoleni, the team brought greetings, presented song items, gave testimony, and I preached at both worship services.
