# Safeguard Your Faith

Associate Pastor Freddy Yong, Lord's Day, 30 October 2022

ear brothers and sisters,
I would like to share with you "safeguard your faith". Philippians
3:1 says, "Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the
Lord. To write the same things to you, to me
indeed is not grievous, but for you it is safe."
Why do we need to safeguard our faith? If we

let our defence down, we are prone to attack. Our faith is very vulnerable to everyday life's oncoming darts and arrows. If they can kill our faith, all our defence will collapse, and we have no protection

against it. If our faith is undermined, our foundation collapsed, then we will have no place to stand against it.

Simple things like sickness, sorrow, misunderstanding, and criticism may cause our faith to waver and question God; why is He not defending us? If we stop trusting the Lord, the next thing we trust is in ourselves or other things other than God. There goes our faith so goes our confidence in the Lord.

The next step you may take is a drastic step – cease praying, cease reading God's Word, and stop going to church. Then you are being secularized and live as non-believers, forgetting God's grace that you once experienced. Next, everything you do becomes mechanical and spiritual life becomes doldrum. Then you cease rejoicing in the Lord and become thankless

Paul reminds us of "these things" - he was referring to more than just rejoicing in the Lord; without a thankful heart, the reality of God in your life is gone, but a make-belief. How do you safeguard your faith from such a sorry state of affairs? Rejoicing seems to be

the best defence of our faith in hard times. Because "for the joy of the Lord is your strength" (Neh. 8:10). You may have problems in life, but joy shall keep you going in your faith.

The Lord is the only one who never changes, which is why I can rejoice in the Lord.

He said, "whatever happens." We're pretty good at rejoicing in the good times, but Paul said that no matter the times, rejoice in the Lord. The key word is "in". When my health breaks down, I don't delight in the brokendown health; I rejoice in the Lord. When I lose my appetite for food, I don't rejoice in losing my appetite; I rejoice in the Lord. When my knees give way, I don't rejoice in the knees' pain. I rejoice in the Lord. The Lord is the only one who never changes, which is why I can rejoice in the Lord. Therefore, "Rejoice in the Lord always and again, I say, rejoice!"

"Whatever happens, my dear brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord. I never get tired of telling you these things, and I do it to safeguard your faith."
