Burning Brightly for Christ

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 13 November 2022

Beloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We have all journeyed hard from the start of this year of 2022. Some of us have managed to stay on track even through personal or family struggles and difficulties, while some of us may have been distracted and sidetracked by certain of the world's attractions and temptations. It is certainly in our natural human nature to go astray and walk away from God (Isaiah 53:6; 1 Peter 2:25). Moreover, our tendency to rely more on our human senses rather than our relationship and trust in God further puts us in a disadvantage. We should rather "walk by faith, not by sight" (2 Cor. 5:7). God Himself encourages us to stay and walk close to Him as He will keep us walking on the right paths (Deut. 5:33; Prov. 3:5-6). In addition, we can also be lights of the Gospel in the lives of other people.

How then are we able to keep on walking with God and continually burn bright for Him?

First, we are to always be consciously aware of God's gracious Presence and Work in our lives. When we have the constant meditation of God's grace, it should cause us to go back to our initial fiery love, passion and dedication for God (Rev. 2:4-5). We would then need to re-evaluate, re-think, and re-prioritise the various commitments, duties, and responsibilities in our lives (Romans 12:1-2). Everything that we do, including our worship, prayer, Bible study, giving, and service to others, is designed and meant to deepen the intimacy of our relationship with God. In addition, we need to allow the Holy Spirit to do His refreshing and re-energizing work and not quench it (put out, stop or prevent it) (Lev. 6:9; 1 Thes. 5:19). We must not allow the busyness of our lives overshadow our need for intimacy with God.

Second, we are to have our hearts and minds washed or cleansed by the Word of God (Eph. 5:26 "That He [Christ] might sanctify and cleanse it [the

church] with the washing of water by the Word"). The sanctifying of our hearts and minds is important as they direct all our thoughts and actions (Prov. 4:23). As we take our daily physical bath or shower, we are also to daily spend our time and immerse our hearts and minds in the Word of God. This would ensure that we would not be easily conformed or moulded into the world's values and principles, but instead be continually renewed and transformed according to God's Word (Romans 12:1-2). It is only through the Word of God that we can grow and mature in our spiritual walk (1 Peter 2:2-3; 2 Tim. 3:16-17). This would help us especially when we go through the furnace of affliction, when our faith would be tried but refined and purified to come out even stronger (1 Peter 1:7).

Third, we are to walk together as a united spiritual community of faith rather than being alone. A lone charcoal cannot remain burning by itself, but only in the presence of other burning charcoals. Similarly, we cannot remain burning bright for Christ except in community. We are given a good example of a God-focused community of the Early Church in Acts 4, without which we can easily lose our focus and attention on God and His things. There is also the need for us to mutually encourage, help, and support one another in various physical, emotional and spiritual ways (Eccl. 4:9-12). This is an important reason why the church leadership has initiated the SSGs (Small Support Groups) throughout the whole church community. Let us all give and provide our whole-hearted support, commitment, and time towards the workings of the various SSGs and their respective leaders.

Let us thus commit ourselves to draw near to God so that we can burn bright for Him (James 4:8 "Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded"). May God continue to bless the work of our hands!
