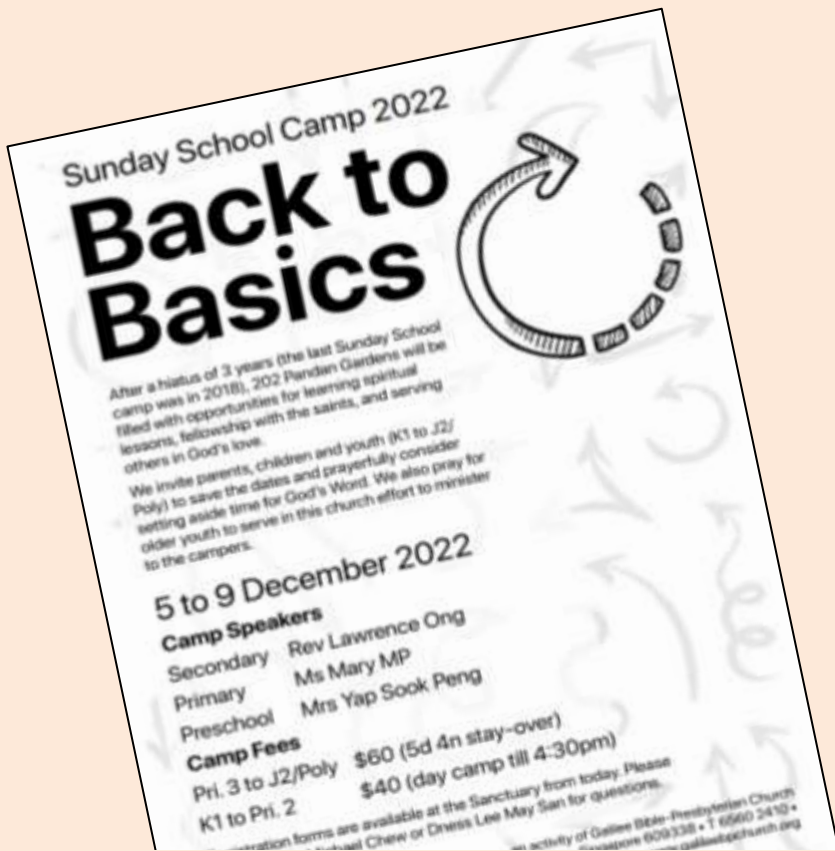



FERVENTLY SERVING THE LORD

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 27 November 2022

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. There are certain things in our lives that we are passionate and committed to such as our personal goals and ambitions, families, and jobs (occupations). Do you ever wonder when we are able to put this same degree of passion, love, and motivation into our Kingdom Work and purposes, what would happen?

First of all, we need to realise that there should not be any dichotomy or separation between secular work and that of the Kingdom. From the time of Creation, God had given Adam work to do (Gen. 2:15). It is also explicitly spelled out in the Ten Commandments that “six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work” (Ex. 20:9). Even among Jesus’ disciples, only 12 of them left their professions and their families to follow and serve with Him, whereas the rest remained in their respective homes and occupations. As such, the work that God has given each of us to do does not only refer to the spiritual work in the church, but also the secular work that God has intended for us to do and serve Him in.

Second, we must realise that there is indeed a deeper meaning and significance behind our work and presence at our workplaces. When we work, we are not only doing it for the mere paycheck and salary, but we do so by having meaningful engagements with people by working with and serving them as we would to our Lord (Col. 3:24). In addition, we are commanded to be the salt and light of the world (Matt. 5:13-16) especially where we work as there is where we spend the majority of our time in contact and in interacting with others. Being the salt and light is not only restricted and limited to our verbal witness for Him, but is also extended to how well we are committed and dedicated to our work, and the good quality and service in our work put toward those we serve and work with (the good works that would glorify our Father which is in heaven mentioned in Matt. 5:16).

Third, we must not neglect God’s kingdom work in the church, and instead prioritise our secular work in the world. God has indeed blessed and given us different spiritual gifts and talents (James 1:17; Romans 12:3-8; 1 Cor. 12). What this means is that we should not be using them merely to gain personal glory, honour and praise, but using them for God’s Kingdom. How then can we meaningful steward and use our spiritual gifts and talents in the world, but not in the Body of Christ, the church to edify and build up one another as fellow believers in Christ (1 Cor. 14:12).

Fourth, we must not depend on our human source of strength, wisdom and capabilities, but that from and of God (1 Cor. 1:25 “Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men”). The Holy Spirit is indeed the One who gives us the true wisdom and full knowledge of God (Eph. 1:17). Having God’s wisdom and power would enable us to burn on instead of burning out for God. We are each in our different phase and stage of life – a student studying in any educational institution, a NSF serving the nation, a young adult or an adult working, a senior adult in retirement. Regardless, it is only our deep and faithful relationship with the Lord, as well as our connection with His Word and with one another, that enables us to persistently and perseveringly follow and carry out His call and leading.

Let us all thus lovingly and not grudgingly serve the Lord and His people with our time, talents and resources including our finances (2 Cor. 9:7 “Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver”). May we strive to receive the good recognition and commendation of Christ “Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord” (Matt. 25:21).
