### Willing Hearts to do God's Work Preacher David Cher, Lord's Dav. 8 January 2023

eloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Thank God for enabling and giving us His grace and strength to fulfil or accomplish what He had placed into our hands to do. No matter what has gone on for the past year, this is a new year with its unique uncertainties and challenges facing us. Thus, regardless, it is much needed that we have our whole heart focused on and committed to do God's Work "without murmurings and disputings" (Phil. 2:14). This can only be done and accomplished when we have our confidence and assurance in God (Phil. 2:13 "For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure").

There are big and great plans to mobilise ourselves as a whole church for His Work especially to reach the community, not only around the physical church building but also the social communities or circles in each of our members' lives. May all of us have the passion and burden in our hearts to reach others for Christ for truly "the harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few" (Matt. 9:37). This also talks about the urgency of doing the harvest work, that "lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest" (John 4:35).

In John 9:4, Jesus said, "[he] must work the works of Him that sent [Him], while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work". First, it is a must or necessity to serve God with all of our time, gifts, and talents out of our love for Him. Second, we must put in the full sense of the work, in not only the mere physical actions of serving but also the entire being of our thoughts and actions with passion and enthusiasm too. Third, working while it is yet day and not yet night points us to the important fact that we must see every God-given opportunity that He has opened the door for us to serve Him, and not let it pass by us. Last Sunday, we have been challenged to pledge our time and effort as measured in the number of hours to each of the LON (Love Our Neighbours) program and event. Let us not delay and encourage one another to commit toward this particular area of loving and serving the LORD for this year. Yet, at the same time, not neglecting and persevering on in other existing areas such as the SSG (Small Support Groups) ministry across all fellowship and age groups.

Challenges and difficulties will surely come in to dilute our energies and commitment that we have set in place at the very start of this year. The Apostle Paul reminds us in 1 Tim 1:12 "And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry" that it is God who sees us fit to call us into His Work and Service. This will help us remain strong and faithful to keep true to His Work. In addition, we will also need to encourage one another not in a sporadic but a continuous manner, knowing that even spiritual giants such as the Apostle Paul and the prophet Elijah also needed times of encouragement and strengthening (2 Tim. 1:16-17 & 1 Kings 19:4-18).

Even when we are able to remain on-track, there is also a great temptation for God's business to become simply busyness. What I mean is that we can become so engaged in all of the church's programs and activities that we neglect our intimacy and walk with God. We are given this contrast between the 2 character examples of Mary and Martha in Luke 10:38-42, that Martha has forgotten the one good thing that Mary was doing in sitting at the feet of Jesus and listening to him.

May God's grace and strength help us fulfil and flourish in our work for this year ahead of us (1 Cor. 15:58 "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord"). And may He also bless the work of our hearts and hands!
