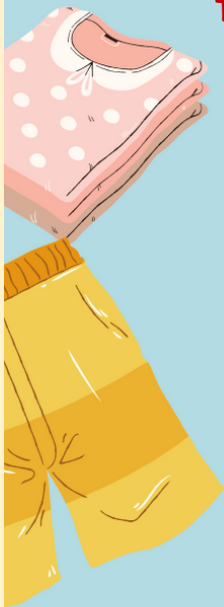

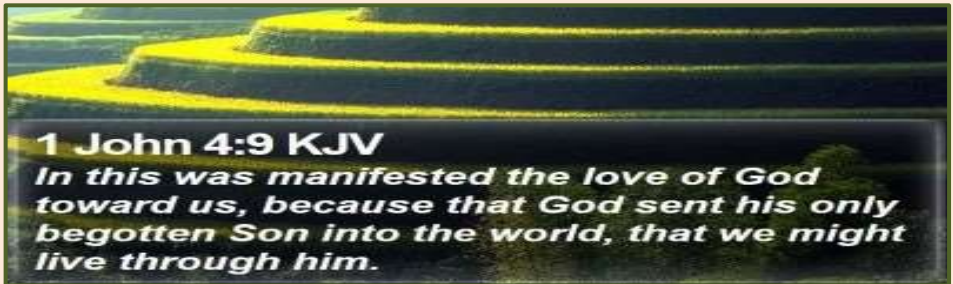

Practical Evangelism

Pastor Freddy Yong, Lord's Day, 29 January 2023

Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Precious
Lord & Saviour, Jesus Christ!

Today's evangelism has changed. We used to go door to door witnessing, and sometimes we were invited by the residents into their homes, and they served us Chinese tea or coke, but today the hosts threatened us, "you don't come and disturb us, huh, or else I call the police". Moreover, we are instructed by the government to exercise social harmony and observe certain rules when doing home visitation. This method isn't effective anymore – we have to change our strategy. The surer way is called 'Action speaks louder than words.'

A better way of sharing the message of Jesus Christ is showing and telling - with both word and deed. People want to see more than listen to your talk. If it's action, it works--get someone a glass of water, give a listening ear, lend a hand or assist by opening the door. When people are shy and reserve, you greet them first. Ask "how you are today?". Show interest in other's woes and concerns. Ask if you can pray for him/her and show concern for their needs. When they are slow to share about themselves, you can take the lead to tell who you are: be honest with your own life, faults, failures, struggles and shortcomings. When they see your sincerity, they will open up. Be humble, and share your inadequacy with others, so they can see the 'real' you and are willing to listen to what you share.

We know the Gospel is the power of God, however, unless Christians care enough to share the good news of Christ, the lost will likely die without hope, separated from God. There is always risk involved when we share Jesus. But we need plenty of love and courage when we practice personal evangelism. If we don't do something, the next moment, they are gone.

This story portrays the urgency of reaching out to people. While he was holding meetings in a Pennsylvania town, a young man who had formerly lived next door to the parsonage committed a murder. The whole community was stirred. Mr Carter and the pastor obtained permission to visit the young man in his cell. After telling him his own story of conversion in prison, Mr Carter and the pastor succeeded in leading him to Christ. Then the newly saved man addressed the pastor and sadly said, "To think I lived next door to you for months, and you never told me anything about Jesus until I came here! If you only had, I probably never would have become a murderer."

Are we overlooking any close-by opportunities? Do it before too late! We share good things quickly. When we hear of any cheap and good deals we promptly tell our neighbours to get them before the end of the offer. Why isn't the same urgency seen in sharing the good news of Jesus Christ, which is much better than cheap and good stuff quickly shared? Are you part of the LON?
