

In Christ, I can do it!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 19 February 2023

Prethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ!

We recognise the challenges faced by the Galileans' weekly prayer requests. Naturally, anxieties, fear, and worries afflict our hearts in such times. We become tired, weak, and even

mummer words of despair in our plight. Questions rise and fall in our minds. Difficult times make us spiritually "anaemic." We need a booster!

The invigorating words of the Apostle Paul to the Philippian Christians, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" (4:13), will do the work perfectly. I have imprinted these

words on my door glass panel as a reminder when I open my cubical door at the start of the day. Each day is different from the other. Here, I recall the words of our Lord, "Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof." Matt 6:34.

Paul has seen the best days of his life and the worst days as well. Circumstances may differ, the nature of problems may vary, and people involved may change, but the hope in Christ and our purpose in Him remains resolute—"For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain." Phil 1:21.

I can do all things in Christ may give the impression that Christians are like "superman" who can display extraordinary power that baffles everyone around us. If we go in this vein, we will find reality speaks otherwise. Paul is saying to the Christians that he will weather the various circumstances by the power of Christ. When he

suffered lack or faced opposition from those who rejected the Gospel, authorities and political forces that treated him unfairly and harshly, and endured the numerous perils in the Gospel mission, he found his source of strength and energy to continue in Christ. Paul commits the situation in prayer and leaves the outcome in the hands of his Saviour, Jesus Christ.

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" Likewise, instead of always coveting fair weather, accepting rough and tough times and emerging well from them is an opportunity to glorify God. When we apply Phil 4:13, the truth will help to reorder our thinking, reset confidence, relieve fear, and release the power in God. The problem may not disappear, but we will not dissolve away in it.

God invites us to call Him in our troubled times, and He promises to not only hear us but to step in and do marvellous things beyond our imagination that will make us breathless (Jer 33:3). Our God is a Living, Almighty, Allknowing, and All-present God. There is none like Him!

King David testified confidently that his help in life was... the Lord: "The LORD is my Strength and my Shield; my heart trusted in Him, and I am helped: therefore, my heart greatly rejoiceth; and with my song will I praise Him" (Psalm 28:7). The Lord helped King David through difficult, even life-threatening times. David knew it in his heart, was ever thankful, and he constantly made right with God.

Brethren, the Lord God Almighty is our strength, our Protector and Defender, an Ever-Present Help. We can trust Him and do all things through Christ Jesus! God Bless!
