Starting Small, Growing Big

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 26 March 2023

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ. 1 Cor. 1:28-29
"And base [insignificant, low] things of the
world, and things which are despised, hath God
chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to
nought things that are: That no flesh should glory
in His Presence". Let us be encouraged that God is
able to use even the small things that we do to
accomplish His greater purposes of His Work. But
God wants us to be faithful in these small things
and then He will give us bigger things to do for Him
(Luke 16:10 "He that is faithful in that which is least
is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the
least is unjust also in much").

First, a humble character that is always dependent on God is foremost important. We are reminded of the fine example of Moses whom God personally recognised to be among the meekest or humblest person who Earth (Numbers 12:3 "Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth"). Even when Moses recognised that he was not eloquent [articulate] and instead was poor in speech, God still used him in His Service to deliver His people Israel from Egypt. Similarly, we need to humbly submit to and follow His purposes and ways.

Second, for us who may think that our resources and abilities are limited, we should be reminded of the example of the 2 poor widows: one during the time of Elisha (2 Kings 4:1-7), and the other during the time of Jesus (Luke 21:1-4). God used the small and limited amount of oil that the first widow had and multiplied it to provide and save her family from debt and slavery. And Jesus commended the faithful though small giving of the second widow. Her 2 mites were surely of a very small amount as a mite was the smallest denomination during ancient Roman times. Thus, God looks beyond the physical act of our giving, and even serving, and into the motivation of our hearts whether it is out of our love for Him or not

Third. God will surely bless the smallest or the feeblest of our efforts of ordinary people like us to fulfil His Work and purposes. The 2 miraculous feeding of the 5000 and 4000 teach us that God is able to use the meagre-looking number of loaves and fishes, and the willing partnership of the small boy and the disciples. When we look at the lives of the 12 disciples, we should realise that all of them come from among the least educated and most looked down upon segments of their society: fishermen, tax collector, and a Zealot [a person who was actively involved in a movement of rebellion against the Roman Empire to expel it forcefully from the Holy Land]. In addition, Gideon in Judges 6-8 was the youngest and smallest in his family but was still chosen together with a meagre number of 300 people in his army to defeat the Midianites. As such, we should not allow our lowly status in our society and family to hinder our efforts for the Lord.

At this time, I would also like to mention the small size but potentially big outcomes or fruits of the Small Support Groups [SSGs] in Galilee Church. To accomplish this, may I encourage all the small group leaders to persevere and press on with their efforts, and all the small group members to encourage your leaders by being responsive and committed to meeting up at least twice per month. The rationale for this is to ensure that even when you miss one meetup, you would not miss the support of your group for too extended a time. We all should realise that being a church community does not involve merely meeting every Sunday morning but should also have the good regularity of our SSG meetings.

Throughout all our efforts for the Lord, let us be reminded to give all honour and glory to Him (1 Cor. 1:30-31 "But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord").
