

Sow, the Gospel Seed

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 5 March 2023

Rethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

On this Mission Sunday, we remind ourselves the ace of all assignments that Christ issued to believers and that is to bring the Gospel to the lost. Jesus said, "I came to seek and save the lost" (Lk 19:10).

The work in evangelism can be compared to that in agriculture. The planters engage in one common activity to diligently prepare the ground, sow the seeds, and reap the harvest, God willing. The work of planting the Gospel seed is ongoing and challenging. Just as the farmer cannot sit waiting for a conducive season and favourable situation to start growing his crops, God's Word reminds the Gospel planter: "... who observes the wind will not sow, and he who regards the clouds will not reap" (Eccl 11:4). The Biblical command for us is: "Preach the Word; be instant in season, out of season" (2 Tim 4:2). We are to evangelise for Christ persistently, always. Regardless of where, when and to whom, we just do it without hesitation but with much care and prayer.

Seizing God-given opportunity to share the Gospel with as many people as possible is crucial. Never, belittle any opportunity, however small or unpromising it may appear to be, just go for it. The tiny mustard seed when sown in the ground, did it not sprout into a big tree among whose branches the birds came and perched? (Matt 13:32). When one person is led to Christ, it carries the possibility for many more to know Christ through the person? (Acts 16:31). This is the principle of disciplemultiplication. The Lord's disciple,

Andrew, introduced the Messiah to his brother Peter (Jn 1:41,42), and we read how the Peter was instrumental to bring thousands to Christ through the faithful preaching of God's Word (Acts 2:41; 4:4).

The work of evangelism requires diligence from all of us. The sower starts at dawn to prepare the soil, plough, sow the seed, water, remove the weeds and fertilise the land. It is hard back-breaking work, but he plods on because there is great anticipation of reward. "He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing his sheaves with him" (Ps 126:5-6). He who sows in tears shall reap in joy.

Here are some simple things we can do to reach out for Christ. Let's invite friends and colleagues to church, Fellowship Groups, SSG meetings, Church Camps, Retreats, and other special calendar events. Pay attention to visitors who come to our Sunday Worship Services. Welcome them warmly into our midst, receive them with congregation applause, share our programmes, and connect them with other brethren. Even in leisure and sports, let's be "evangelism conscious."

Brethren, bringing a person to Christ is the most rewarding activity for the Christian for it changes the eternal destiny of a person. Kicks off a celebration in heaven—"There is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth." (Lk 15:10). Only the Word of God has the power to do so. Come, "ambassadors for Christ" bring the "Word of reconciliation" and glad tidings of joy and peace to a lost mankind (2Cor 5:18-20). God Bless!
