"Children's Spiritual Enrichment" Pastor Simon. Lord's Day, 19 March 2023

Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Praise and thank God for the Vacation Bible School the CF/JF ministry organised. Thirty-two children came for the VBS. Teachers, students and helpers enjoyed fellowship with one another, and the weather was conducive to exciting outdoor activities. Dness Lee May San and I brought God's Word from the theme: "Faith Is The Victory" Joshua 6:1-27. Seizing the opportunity, the teachers shared the Gospel with at least 14 youngsters one-on-one, and others for assurance of salvation. We thank our Lord for sustaining the children's ministry over these many years.

Children are especially dear to the Lord, and He pays particular attention to them. Matthew in His Gospel recorded for us, "Then were there brought unto Him little children, that He should put His hands on them, and pray: and the disciples rebuked them. But Jesus said, <u>Suffer little children</u>, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven. And He laid His hands on them and departed thence." Matt 19:13-15. It was customary for parents to bring their infants and little children to distinguished rabbis for their blessings.

First, notice the parents brought the children to the Lord. Children's spiritual condition should be every parent's top priority in our church. In Duet 6:6-8, "And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart: And <u>thou shalt</u> <u>teach them diligently unto thy children</u>, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes."

The parents could have taken them to fun places

for their children to play with friends. Or they stayed home to do mundane household chores. Or they were gone to visit relatives and friends. Notice the parents didn't bring the sick children for healing since no one could fix the kids' health problems. These were normal, healthy, happy kids. Simply, the parents were interested in their children's spiritual well-being. All they wanted from the Lord was for Him to lay hands (bless) and pray for them. The children will remember this trip and who they met, the words they heard and the gentle voice of prayer. The parents will recount this incident and revise the learnings on the way back.

Next, when the parents brought their little children and infants to Jesus, the disciples disallowed and rebuked them. Why? The disciples taught Jesus time could be used more beneficially and constructively than to be wasted on children. They were not appreciating how the parents regarded Jesus, taking leave from their routine occupation, and travelling some distance to meet the Lord. When they found Him, the disciples' blocked them from seeing Jesus. Their mindset was children were the least of their master's concerns.

Over time, secular norms and directives have made deep inroads into us where biblical values and priorities are side-lined. Parents make significant sacrifices to enrich their children with the best education and other enrichment programs to secure a promising future. Like the disciples discount the worth of the children before God, we, as parents, could do more justice to allot time and resources for our children's Bible knowledge and spiritual progress. Parents rightfully should pray for their children and dutifully covet the Lord's blessings on them. God Bless!
