REMAINING ON FIRE FOR GOD'S WORK

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 23 April 2023

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord
and Saviour Jesus Christ. On last Sunday, I
reminded all of us that we as human beings
are indeed the pinnacle of God's creative work on
the sixth and last day of creation (Gen. 1:27 "So
God created man in his own image, in the image of
God created he him; male and female created he
them"). In addition, we as the apple of His eye
would always be under His constant watch and
care (Ps. 17:8).

Having this comfort and assurance from God does not mean that we should just remain and be contented in our comfort zones. The taking up of our crosses as mentioned in both Matt. 19:24 and Luke 9:23 is surely not comfortable and involves sacrifices on our part. As such, we must remain steadfast and persevere in our serving to all persons and in all circumstances. Christ did not choose who and when to serve, and we as His followers should not be selective in our serving too (Matt. 20:28; Mark 10:45). God has indeed given each of us different gifts and talents (James 1:17; 1 Peter 4:10-11) and His grace to do so (2 Cor. 12:9).

The phrase "God's Work" should always remind us that it is indeed His Work and not ours. God must always be the focus and motivation behind our work for Him. God has moved our hearts and intentionally placed each of us in the different ministries and areas of service of Galilee Church. Let us continue to be faithful with each small and big duty, task, and responsibility that we are given to do. It is also while we are serving that we exercise our gifts and talents alongside others to form effective and fruitful serving teams. We must see that active service in God's Work is part of God's process to shape our person and character into what He wants us to be. But beyond that is to love and serve others (Gal.5:13-14) with their

needs, interests, and spiritual growth even over ours.

Our understanding of serving should also not be only limited and restricted to our physical actions of serving in the different church ministries and areas of service. Instead, when we understand it more to be more than actions but an attitude, we would then naturally extend it to the whole of our lives. God is our Master and Lord, and we are to serve Him and He alone with our lives (Col. 3:23-24 "And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ve serve the Lord Christ"). God calls us to not only serve Him in church, but also in our families whether immediate or extended, and in society at large in specific and different ways and means (1 Cor. 7:17a-b "But as God hath distributed to every man, as the Lord hath called every one, so let him walk...").

We must remain connected to God throughout the whole process of our serving. If we are merely serving in our strength, we would surely run out of it. As Isaiah 40:29 says "He [God] giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength", we are instead to turn to God as our source of strength in our service for Him. This leads us on to the related point of remaining connected to God through time spent in His Word. Also, we should have the Holy Spirit instead of our human spirit to fill and empower us (Zech. 4:6b "...Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts"), as well as lead and guide us how we are to serve God in the various areas of our lives.

Brethren, let us press on in our service for God, knowing that our faithfulness would certainly be recognised and commended by Him (Matt. 5:21, 23).
