

## **ABIDE IN ME!**

## Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 7 May 2023


Brethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ. Today, Holy
Communion Sunday, allow me to share with you
this account: Apollo 11 landed on the moon's
surface on Sunday, 20 July 1969. To this day,
many remember astronaut Neil Armstrong's
historical statement as he stepped onto the
moon's surface: "That's one small step for a
man; one giant leap for mankind". But few knew
about that first meal eaten on board Apollo 11.
Astronaut Buzz Aldrin, the Lunar Module pilot
who manned this first lunar landing in history.

wrote in his memoirs: "The radio blackout, I opened the little plastic packages which contained the bread and the wine. I poured the wine into the chalice our church had given me. In the moon's onesixth gravity, the wine slowly curled and gracefully came up the side of the cup. Then I read the Scripture, "I am the Vine, you are the branches. Whosoever abides

in Me will bring forth much fruit" Jn 15:5. I ate the tiny host and swallowed the wine. I gave thanks for the intelligence and spirit that had brought two young pilots to the Sea of Tranquillity".

How amazing this disciple of Jesus! A historical moment when everyone on earth was celebrating this astounding feat of mankind, patting each other on the back for this great accomplishment of mankind, astronaut Aldrin looked up to the Lord God, the Maker of the universe. As he quietened his heart in worship and gave God the glory for man's achievement, God's Word reminded him to continue to abide in the Lord, for then, and only then, would believers bear much fruit. Brethren, are you at this moment feeling alone, far away from home and loved ones? Maybe you have just clinched

a big business deal, passed a major hurdle in life, and are rejoicing in mountain-top euphoria. Perhaps, you are feeling down, struggling to walk through the shadows of a dark valley of life. Remember that God's Abiding Presence is always with you, no matter your circumstance. God is only a prayer away; you can commune with Him right where you are. We don't have to travel far across the ocean to seek the Lord. Through communion in prayer, the reading of God's Word and living in obedience to Christ daily, we can abide in the Lord wherever we are—at home, at work, in school, on travel



overseas. Anywhere, anytime, God has given us the privilege and blessing to abide in Jesus. God's Abiding Presence is with us 24/7. Psalm 139 tells us that God is intimately present with us wherever we go. On the moon's surface, far from earth, astronaut Aldrin consciously and diligently took time and effort to commune with and

thank the Creator God for enabling him and his colleague to achieve the marvellous feat. As the branch cannot bear fruit except it abides in the vine, we can do nothing except when we abide in Jesus.

Brethren, without God breathing life into us, we are just but dust. God's Spirit, His presence and grace sustain us through life on earth. Man, the created must be connected to the Creator Vine, the Lord God Almighty, from Whom we receive our breath, the spiritual sap of life and nourishment. How well we grow spiritually depends on how much "nourishment" we seek from the Lord. Daily abiding in and fellowshipping with Christ is the secret of our spiritual wellbeing and vivacity in the faith. God Bless!
