



BUILDING KINGDOM-DRIVEN FAMILIES

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 14 May 2023

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As we
celebrate Mother's Day today, we are
reminded of two key facts that healthy
families are the foundation and building
blocks of a stable and growing nation as well
as local churches, and that each family
member whether as husband, wife, or children
play and contribute toward the building up of
their families.

We who are parents are given the role and responsibility from God to steward, nurture, and care for the children under us to ensure that they grow not only physically, but also spiritually. socially, mentally. emotionally as following the pattern of our Lord Jesus Christ (Luke 2:52 "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man"). Oftentimes, we parents including myself and my wife have our time stretched with our work, family, and other commitments. Thus, it is extremely easy for us to slip into just merely moving from one activity to another without the intentionality of investing deeply into the lives of our children. In addition, our energies are drained at the end of the day when we get back with our families. At this point, we parents are reminded to carefully monitor and manage our emotions and feelings such that we do not jeopardise the proper bringing up of our children (Eph. 6:4 "And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord").

Not only does the responsibility of the family lie solely with the husband, but the wife as his help meet or helper would share it with him (Gen. 2:18 "And the Lord God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him"). The husband is to provide his loving leadership for the family

(Eph. 5:23), and the wife is to lovingly and respectfully support or help her husband throughout the entire process (Eph. 5:22). There is also the balancing or counteracting effect that the wife provides for the husband. In our Singaporean Asian context, the image of the husband is commonly seen to be one of commanding or authoritarian figure, whereas the wife can be seen to be one that is more approachable, relatable and able to provide the practical comfort that the children needs (Isaiah 66:13 "As one whom his mother comforteth, so will I comfort you; and ve shall be comforted in Jerusalem"). This would ensure that both the instructive and caring or compassionate aspects are present and experienced by the children in their respective families.

Our attention as parents should also not be only on the present, but also focusing on training and developing their person and character for what lies ahead for them in the future (Prov. 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it"). This is far more important than leaving to them mere material and physical riches (Prov. 13:22 "A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children; and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just"). The inheritance of the good man as mentioned in Proverbs 13:22 has a much wider range of good moral stability and goodness as compared to the transient or temporal nature of wealth or riches.

May God grant us parents His wisdom and guidance as to how we are to lead and guide our families in His ways (Ps. 127:1, 3 "Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain... Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is His reward").
