Praise & Magnify The Lord!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 2 June 2023

Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. On this day, our hearts overflow with joy and thanksgiving! Praise and thank God for the privilege of celebrating our church's 63rd Anniversary. Our hearts resonate with David and his words, "I will bless the Lord at all times: His praise shall continually be in my mouth." Ps 34:1. Not responding appropriately to anyone's kindness is unnatural. God is no exception. The proper reaction to God's grace, goodness, and mercies is to praise Him. We must say thank you, Lord! Both for small and big things. Quizzes and exams. Failures and successes. Predicament or promotion. Perpetually grateful to the Lord. Praising the Lord is the church's consistent way of life.

David says, "His soul boasts in the Lord" v:2. Our gratefulness must not sit deep and quiet in the heart, instead, we are called to broadcast our praises to God.
