

#### North Vietnam Mission Trip Report (4-11 June 2023)

Team Members: Preacher David Cher (I/C), Dness Jeannie Yeo, Sis Low Yuet Ling, Sis Chay Mei Yoke, Sis Adeline Simon, Sis Diana Chan, Sis Debra Ang, and Sis Isabelle Chung

Thank God for a fruitful and meaningful trip that the team had in Hanoi, North Vietnam. This trip is a follow-up one from last year's trip as invited by our contact Sis Rebekah Yam from Nazareth BPC to her new school setup named as Mustard Seed Academy having students from ages 5 to 16.

For this year's children camp, we were given the children ages 7 to 13 to focus on as at the same time as this camp, there was a teens' camp being run by another group too. There was a total of 44 children (21 older ones: ages 10-13 years old; 23 younger ones: ages 7 to 9 years old), some of which were invited guests from Duc Luc which is in another province.

Thank God for each team member's contribution and serving the LORD in the children's camp from 5 to 9 June (a total of 5 days from 8.30 am in the morning to 4.30 pm in the afternoon). The team was divided into two: Preacher David Cher, Dness Jeannie Yeo, and Sis Chay Mei Yoke teaching the older ones, and the rest of Sis Adeline Simon, Sis Diana Chan, Sis Debra Ang, and Sis Low Yuet Ling teaching the younger ones.

For each day of the children's camp, there would be combined singing and memory verse, morning devotions, Bible stories, craft sessions, and English and Science sessions. On 8 June (Thursday), we also had a sports' day during which the younger children were brought in the morning, and the older ones in the afternoon, to a nearby park to enjoy the outdoors and have fun group activities together. On 9 June (Friday), we had a camp presentation which the parents of the children were invited, after which we had a food gathering, as a fitting end to the children's camp.

May God bless the work of our hands, and the continued work of Sis Rebekah Yam and her team in Mustard Seed Academy, Hanoi, that they bear fruit in the hearts and lives of the children and their families too.

#### "... Every Word of God"

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 18 June 2023

#### Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. We have arrived at our first post-pandemic Church Camp, with 105 campers, all geared to fellowship in the Word of God and with one another. Our last Church Camp was in 2019 – the theme was "Heart of Worship", the speaker was from Hong Kong, Dr David Pardini, and the venue was Hotel Tenera, Kuala Lumpur. At the dawn of the following year, the pandemic racked havoc globally, but thanks to God, we as a church survived by His mercy and grace. The Psalmist declares, "For the Lord is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endureth to all generations" Ps 100:5.

Last year, we held an In-house Church Camp to mitigate health risks. Praise and thank God, this year, we are back to the good old days, taking a break from our daily routines to experience spiritual, physical, and social refreshment as believers of the same body of Christ.

The Church Camp Committee has put in many hours of diligent hard work to make this a blessed camp by negotiating the best price with facilities suitable for all campers, carefully selecting the menu to treat the pallets of the young and seniors, sourcing and organising afternoon outdoor activities and ensuring meeting rooms which are well equipped. The committee members made several trips to Sheraton Desaru to ensure all prearrangements were in place. We thank Camp Master Bro Albert Ng and his team for a job well done!

Programmes for English & Mandarin campers, as well as the children, will run concurrently. May our Lord bless our various Camp Speakers: Rev Lee Fatt Ping (Grace BPC), Rev David Tan (Chen Li

Presbyterian Church) and Sister Hannah Yeo (Grace BPC, Children Speaker). We welcome Rev Richard Musyoki, who arrived from Kenya, Africa, on Friday to join us and his family for this camp. Pastor Richard, before breakfast, will bring morning devotions to us.

We will study the Eight Beatitudes from the Gospel of Matthew 5:1-12 at camp. Professor William Harding delivered the last exposition on this passage in June 2009. Brethren, let us not miss out on any of the messages. Let us come with the attitude to learn and the appetite to ingest the precious Word of God. Jesus said, "It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God" Matthew 4:4.

Someone remarked that the Beatitudes serve as the doctrine of the Disciples. Dale Bruner, "The Sermon on the Mount is, spiritually speaking, actually the Sermon from the valley. It starts low. It starts with those who feel very unlike mountains!"

May the Lord enrich us through His Word, strengthen our bonds with one another, and revive our spiritual life. May God grant us journeying mercies to and from this camp!

Lastly, the Pastoral Team, Board of Elders and Session wish all fathers a Blessed Father's Day. Our heavenly Father is the model for all fathers.
