Our Youths - Our Plants & Pillars

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 16 July 2023

Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Praise and thank God for our youths' determination and fortitude to hold the Youth Worship Service on the third Sunday from this month forward. The Lord has sustained the Youth WS for twenty-two long years. Many brethren had served well in various roles in the past with passion and love for the Lord.

From a retrospective view, the Youth WS has seen shifts and changes to meet its objectives. Galilee Youth WS was inaugurated on Lord's Day, 15th July 2001. We conducted YWS every 4th Sunday of the month. The key objective was to cater to the spiritual needs of our youths with topics relevant to their daily challenges. Next, to invite other youths outside the fold of Christ. Upon review, on 26th January 2019, the church leaders felt that Youth WS may be more evangelistically effective if it is held on the fourth Saturday of each month at 5 pm. The programme went on well for a while until COVID-19 showed up. During the pandemic period attendance weaned, and enthusiasm thinned. The Church Session assessed the feedback from the youths and decided to shift the Youth WS to the third Sunday of each month.

I encourage our Youth to gladly attend the Youth WS and serve in any possible way you can. Let's renew our interest to invite siblings, nephews, nieces, and friends to our church. The Bible says, "For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have showed toward His Name, in that, ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister" Hebrews 6:10.

We can whole-heartedly share King David's earnest prayer, "**That our sons may be as plants grown up in the youth; that our daughters may be as corner stones, polished after the similitude of a palace:**" Ps 144:12.
