# **Gaining Spiritual Understanding**

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 23 July 2023

eloved Brethren,

Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. As humans, we all have the intrinsic or inborn desire for knowledge and wisdom. Thus, a good level of education and job experience are seen as valuable sources of knowledge and wisdom. But we are reminded from God's Word that knowing God and His Will is surely more important and valuable than them (Col. 1:9 "For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding").

In this area of understanding God and His Will (His Word and related biblical principles), it is surely a never-ending and lifelong pursuit. This means that no one would ever stop or graduate from it. As such, each of us must always seek to have an insatiable or persistent thirst for God and His things (Ps. 42:1 "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after Thee, O God"; 1 Peter 2:2-3 "As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious"). As compared to the things of the world, how is our desire for God and His things compared to them?

In addition to gaining and attaining new levels of knowledge and understanding about God, it is also inclusive of softening and opening our minds and hearts to His workings in our lives (Eph. 1:17-18 "That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints"). May we overcome the temptation and inclination to become dull and apathetic in the face of God's Truth such that we lovingly grasp and hold tight to it in all seasons of our lives.

But can we effectively grow on our own in the comfort of our private study and surroundings? In coming together with fellow believers, we would not struggle with remaining in the narrow well of our self-understanding and move on to reflecting on and expanding our understanding of familiar as well as not-so-familiar Bible passages and principles. It is also of no accident that the Bible record for us a total of 59 "on anothers" such as loving, forgiving, and encouraging one another. We would also strengthen, motivate, and encourage one another to apply the truths of God's Word in the cauldron of our everyday life including our interactions with unbelievers (James 1:22 "But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves": Heb. 10:24 "And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works").

There is also no personal spiritual growth without the pains of trials and tribulations (John 16:33 "These things I have spoken unto you, that in Me ye might have peace. In the world ve shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world"). During the heat of such moments, we may question why God is sending or allowing us to go through them. But we are reminded that our character would be developed in her godly aspects toward that of Christ (Romans 8:29 "For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren"). Our faith would also be made pure and strengthened too (1 Peter 1:7 "That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ").

As J.I. Packer said, "The healthy Christian is not necessarily the extrovert, ebullient Christian, but the Christian who has a sense of God's presence stamped deep on his soul, who trembles at God's word, who lets it dwell in him richly by constant meditation upon it, and who tests and reforms his life daily in response to it."
