Give Thanks with Grateful Hearts

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 2 July 2023

Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. The psalmist encourages all Christians at every place, under every circumstance, to make space to give thanks to the Lord—“O come, let us sing unto the Lord: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving and make a joyful noise unto Him with psalms. For the Lord is a great God and a great King above all gods. Psalm 95:1-3.

God desires in all of us a grateful heart. Life consists of various situations, especially the dreaded and difficult ones that could numb our minds and hearts from appreciating God. We have been through such moments. A few things we can learn from the three verses in Psalm ninety-five.

First, “O come, let us” - we have a responsibility to coach others or remind others of the importance of looking up to God. When one believer is hurting, the whole community hurts with them. The Bible says, “Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep” Romans 12:15. The stronger ones will coax the weaker ones to remember to give thanks to the Lord. When unfavourable things happen, it helps to assure ourselves that the situation and damages could have been worse. Let us lock arms with the congregation to give thanks to the Lord.

Next, sing unto the Lord - Only Christians could sing in dire times. Their songs are not one of hopeless lamentation, like the secular songs prompt, but one of victory. Our Hymns and songs express our complete dependence on the Lord. He is the God of all gods. There isn't a power greater than our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. The Scriptures teach us that, “Ah Lord God! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power

and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for Thee.” Jeremiah 18:14, Gen 18:14. Salvation from all earthly adverse situation is in the Lord. Our Lord who gave Himself on the cross to save us from eternal damnation (John 5:24), will He hesitate for a moment to save us from temporal challenges (Rom 8:32)? Of course not! Though we may experience a darkest season in the valley, we will be alright for His rod and staff will comfort us (Ps 23:4). Let us make a joyful sound to the Rock of our salvation.

Next, let us come before His presence: At the beginning of each Sunday Worship service we sing, “the Lord is in His holy temple” to remind ourselves that we are in God's presence to worship Him. The very expression of a grateful heart is the exercise of worship of God. There is always something going on in our lives, but we put them aside and rivet our focus on God who pilots our lives perfectly according to His will and plan. Let us not allow anything do dampen our spirit to love and walk with Him.

Lastly, our God is a great God: Brethren, human language is a weak vehicle to convey the greatness of God altogether. The song that readily comes to mind is, “*The love of God is greater far than tongue or pen can ever tell It goes beyond the highest star and reaches to the lowest hell... To write the love of God above would drain the ocean dry nor could the scroll contain the whole though stretched from sky to sky...*” Every milestone in our lives testifies the goodness and mercies of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Praise and thank God for a blessed Church Camp. Today, we praise God as we mark Sunday School 63rd Anniversary, Mandarin Worship service 32nd Anniversary and Youth Worship Service 22nd Anniversary. Honour and glory
