# **Dual Family Ties**

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 20 August 2023

Rethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ. Every believer in the Church is
part of God's "forever" family and belongs to
"the household of God" (Eph 2:19). We are brothers
and sisters in Christ. This truth ought to impact the
way we live and relate with one another in the Body of
Christ. God's precious Word conveys two important
truths:

### The Church As Family

When the people drew the Lord Jesus' attention to His family members who were standing at the edge of the multitude, our Lord responded: "Who are My mother and My brothers?" (Mk 3:33b). His answer possibly stunned many people around Him. Interestingly, the Lord Jesus then "looked round about Him... and said. Behold My mother and My brethren! For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is My brother, and My sister, and mother" (Mk 3:34,35). These words of our Lord must have startled the people further. Our Lord did not sever His earthly family ties. Neither was He discounting His family. Even in the final hours of His life while He hanged in agony on the Cross, our loving Saviour was concerned for His earthly mother. Mary, and entrusted her to the care of His beloved disciple (Jn 19:26,27). Christ's emphasis to the multitude was the kinship for the believers beyond the natural family, a bond as deep as "flesh and blood"that is, the spiritual kinship of those who obey God and do His Will. Christ was concerned that believers maintain unity and oneness of heart. The spiritual family is precious to the Lord. Do we treasure our spiritual family?

Our Lord taught us to value our spiritual family by showing love, concern, and commitment and promoting unity in the Body of Christ. We need to remind ourselves constantly that we are members of the Church family, joined together in a deep and abiding Covenant relationship with Jesus as the Lord (Rom 10:9). The SSG ministry is to facilitate this amiable situation in the church. Care, share and bear

one to another in brotherly love for we are one in the bond of Christ. Paul writes, "Who (God) comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God." 2 Cor 1:4. We are in this together!

The Church is not a "spiritual supermarket" where we go in only to pick what we need, and then leave quickly minding our business. The Church is where the believers congregate to worship and serve God, and fellowship with one another. Our Lord Jesus emphasized the importance of the spiritual family. What can we do for each other in the family of God? How can we help each other go through the tough patches of life? Sincere concern for each other will strengthen the Body of Christ and the Church.

### The Family As Church

By using the illustration of the family to typify the Church, the Lord Jesus is also teaching us how we ought to relate to each other in our natural family at home. The family that God has blessed us with, is like the Church in miniature and ought to reflect the love of God. The more we consider and respect each other in the family of God, the more we will love and honour our dear ones at home. What we do for each other in Church in obedience to the commandments of God, we ought to do likewise for our family members.

Our relationship with God must first be right. We must develop a close and personal relationship with the Lord. It is only as we walk closely with the Lord as individuals that we will draw close to the brethren in Church, and our loved ones at home— our spouse, children, parents, and siblings. We are to love the non-believers in our family with the love of God, trusting God to bring them into His family in His good time. Interestingly, how we relate to each other at home shows up in the way we relate to members of the Church, and vice-versa. Indeed, how blessed brethren are in the Lord!
