

## **Connecting With Community**

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 17 September 2023

Prethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ. Praise and thank God for His
goodness for the last two weeks' teaching

ministry in Kathmandu, Nepal. Thank you for your prayer support.

Yesterday, people from our neighbourhood and others from elsewhere came for our Really Free Market program. We thank God that we could bless them with clothes, toys, books, appliances, kitchen wares, and other stuffs that meet their practical needs. Galileans contributed willingly,

helped sorting out the contributions, arranged the items categorically for display, and help run the event. Praise God for the camaraderie!

The church, for a while now, has intentionally stepped out of her comfort zone to reach out to touch people's lives in our community. We started with Really Free Market. Then ventured to partner with St. Luke Elder Care and boldly attempted Galilee Community Day and overwhelmed by the people's response. God willing, other initiatives in the pipeline will come to pass.

Our Lord fervently taught the Word, intensely challenged false beliefs, patiently counselled the ignorant, reformed incorrect norms and persuaded men and women to repent of their sins and come into the Kingdom of God. The church will do no less but emulate the Lord and play her role effectively as the lighthouse of the world (Matt 5:14a).

The Lord also was sensitive to the regular physical and social needs of people. On two occasions, large crowds formed to hear Jesus' message on the Kingdom of God. He did not inconsiderately dismiss the people at the end of His discourse. Compassionately, our Lord sat the people down and instructed His disciples to serve meals. No one went home famished. Possibly, on these occasions the Lord's message resulted in some with salvation, while

others dismissed it and remained in their lost state. However, vividly in their mind the miraculous meals imprinted. Jesus knew them, He said, "...verily, verily,

"As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men" Galatians 6:10a I say unto you, Ye seek Me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled" John 6:26. Despite His kindness towards the people "... many of His disciples went back and walked no more with Him." John 6:66. Our Lord, knew from the start who in the crowd would and who would not believe in Him. In His divinity, He knew, their thoughts and their hearts. Matt 9:4, (Ps

139:2b). But that did not deter the Lord from doing good for others. He fed them! His approach only amplifies His generosity, common grace, and genuine compassion for others. We should develop the same mindset as our Lord. We must avoid focusing on the salvation results always but celebrate the goodness we could bring in the Name of Christ to one and all in our community.

Yes, our underlying intention in any of these outreach events is to win men and women for Christ. Nevertheless, we must keep in mind salvation is of the Lord (Jonah 2:9). The people met and interacted with Jesus, the Son of God, the bread of life, who promised them that they would never go hungry [spiritual sense] (John 6:35). Despite that, many simply settled for only the physical bread. They were only interested in the now, for this life but spiritual needs were the furthest from their mind.

We must not be disappointed when people come for our outreach events stay riveted in their earthly needs and display disinterest for their spiritual needs. We do our part going to the highways and byways to compel people to come to any of these events (Lk 14:23). We will persevere to creatively design programmes, explore avenues to evangelise. Results, always, we leave to the Lord!
