Truth Liberates Us Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 29 October 2023

rethren. In the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, I greet you on this Reformation Sunday, Falsehood was first begotten in the Garden of Eden. Since then, every nook and cranny of our world has been densely polluted with half-truths. Our societal system is infiltrated with lies. Speaking the truth is out of fashion. Honesty is hardly recognised or celebrated. Someone once said pure gold is too soft. For practical purpose, gold mixed with other metals (impure) strengthen it and thus enhance its task. Truth plus something less makes life doable. As I follow the Middle East conflict closely. I observed that lies enjoy wider and louder propaganda than truth. Lies sell better than the truth! How could believers live and strive in this broken world where truth isn't entirely the currency for life?

Jesus said, "And ye shall know the TRUTH, and the TRUTH shall make you free." John 8:32. First, our Lord exhorts us "to know the truth." Implying that we don't exactly have all the truth to begin with. Though, we are not completely void of truth (Rom 2:15), our knowledge and intelligence are tempered with untruth. Hence, our perception and outlook, treatment and analysis are "impure." The paradigms we apply to fix problems are warped. Besides, the physical realm, before we came to Christ, our spiritual dimension was unspeakably deplorable. Our beliefs, worship, and practices were adjacent to the Word of God. To be honest, we didn't know better. We were blinded. Paul testifies that the god of the world (the devil) kept us blind lest we come to the light (2 Cor 4:4).

Our Lord Jesus is calling us to revamp our system, renew our outlook, revisit our priorities, demolish spiritual strongholds, and reorder our priorities in the light of the Holy Scriptures. The Bible says, "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." This knowledge of God's Word requires a lot of effort and discipline. It is not like downloading software onto our mobile phones. At a press of a button, we are upgraded to the next level of usage.

The Psalmist gives us an idea of how we should look at God's Word and how we appropriate it: "But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditates day and night." Unless, we have the joyous drive to study God's Word, the scriptural impact on us will be minimal. Next, the knowledge of God's word must be assimilated into our hearts and minds. The type of meditation the world prescribes requires participants to empty their minds. Remember, the quote, "An empty mind is the devil's workshop." But the Bible invites us to fill our minds and saturate our hearts with His Word. Next, it is a lifelong commitment for all believers. At every station of our lives, challenges and problems evolve. We need to process the headwinds with clarity and make choices pleasing to the Lord. Likewise, the learning of God's truth continues and our perception and maturity over time evolves as well (Rom 12:2).

Next, the Lord promises that "the truth will set us free." The Lord highlights that there is a crucial need to set ourselves free from our old ways through the Word of God. The lack of God's Word in us keeps us very much identical to our pre-conversion selves. There will be hardly any changes. Only the truth has the power to set us free from the twisted physical and spiritual ideologies and doctrines that we have been familiar with. When the Gospel broke into our lives, fundamentally, we found our freedom from idolatry. From spiritual deadness, we became spiritually alive. That is not the end, we need to Growing in the Word will enable us to grow! unshackle from numerous nonsensical ideals and beliefs. Unfetter from self-demeaning perceptions, and joyless life. The presence of God's Word will create in us the space to forgive others, and the grace to accommodate difficult people. God's Word will gradually mature the biblical gualities detailed in the fruit of the Spirit in us all. The Truth Indeed, set us FREE! By God's grace, we will do well!!
