One Family In Christ!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 19 November 2023

Rethren,
Greetings in the Name of our Lord and
Saviour Jesus Christ. Nearing the close of
the year, our hearts are filled with
thanksgiving, songs of praises serenading in us for
all God's mercies, grace, and bountiful blessings
on us. Yes, the year was challenging, there were
surprises and uncertain moments but all in all the
Lord has been good to us. Praise the Lord!

Recently, our Associate Pastor Rev Freddy Yong took up Singapore citizenship. He is no longer a foreigner but one of us, a resident of our beloved Island-City state. Paul writes to his Gentile readers who were formerly aliens and foreigners but now through Christ, they have become fellow citizens of God's family— "Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God." Eph 2:19. Besides, our biological family, by our born-again experience in Christ, we enjoy dual family ties. Every believer in our Church is part of God's "forever" family and belongs to "the household of God." Not here and in the church alone, but we are brothers and sisters in Christ for eternity. This eternal bond and existence are not always shared in and by the natural family. This spiritual truth ought to influence the way we look, treat, work, and live with one another as members of the Body of Christ.

On one occasion, when Jesus was talking to the crowd, He was informed that His family members were standing at the edge keen to speak to Him. Our Lord responded: "Who is My mother? and who are my brethren?" (Matt 12:48). His answer must have stunned the people around Him, for that matter, even us. Interestingly, the Lord Jesus then looked round about Him... and said, "For whosoever shall do the will of My Father which is in heaven, the same is My brother, and sister, and mother" (Matt 12:50). These words of our Lord startled the people further. Surely, our Lord did not

belittle or sever His earthly family ties. Remember, even in the final hours of His life while He hanged in agony on the Cross, our loving Saviour was concerned for His earthly mother, Mary, and entrusted her to the care of His beloved Disciple (Jn 19:26,27). Christ's emphasis to the multitude that day was that there is kinship for the believers beyond the natural family, a bond as deep as "flesh and blood" -- that is, the spiritual kinship of those who obey God and do His Will.

The church family is precious to the Lord. We must treasure her and be proud of her. Let's avoid comparing our church with other churches. We have our own unique history, culture, and practices. Hence, we are peculiar and precious to our Lord Jesus Christ— "the apple of His eye" Ps 17:8.

Our Lord taught us to value our spiritual family. To exercise love, care, concern, and commitment, and promote unity in the Body of Christ. Amidst the fierce and demanding daily schedules, we need to be ever conscious as members of the Church family, are joined together in a deep and abiding Covenant relationship with Jesus and with one another. Let us honour, support, care, and encourage fellow brethren in the Lord. The Church is not a "spiritual supermarket" where we go in to pick what we need from the shelves and then quickly depart. Instead, the Church is where the believers congregate to worship and serve God, and our Lord Jesus Christ together.

Brethren, what can we do for each other in the family of God? How can we help each other go through the tough patches of life, and grow in spiritual maturity? Sincere concern for each other will strengthen the Body of Christ and the Church. Galilee is our family; our family is Galilee!

May God help us!
