

# In His Time!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 3 December 2023

Brethren,
Season's Greetings in the Name of our
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. After eleven
months of journey, by His grace, experiencing and
surviving a potpourri of situations, we stepped into
this joyous Christmas month. We are rightly
inundated with a celebrative festive mood of
thanksgiving for God's goodness, mercies, and
grace!

Paul writes to the Galatians that "... when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth His Son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them...that we might receive the adoption of sons. Gal 4:4-5. Since the first mention of the Saviour to redeem us from the curse and tyranny of sin (Gen 3:15), for thousands of years, nothing happened. Prophets after prophets echoed the prophecy of a redeemer that is to come but generations after generations remained unrealised. Possibly, they would have wondered when this Saviour would ever come, especially during Israel's difficult times-while they were in exile on foreign soil or under foreign powers. But note: "God can't lie" Heb 6:18b. After four hundred vears of the intertestamental period of silence, at the fullness of time, the prophecy finally came to pass. Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ broke into human history, in flesh and blood, as one of us, conceived uniquely yet without sin to redeem lost mankind (Phil 2:6-8). Thus, we have Christmas! A couple of thoughts here:

First, God never goes back on His word. We have made promises to others and found ourselves unable to fulfil them. With tongue-in-the-cheek, we explain in all humility our difficulties in keeping to our words. Not that we are deliberately seeking to mislead or let anyone down. Regrettably, our overconfidence does not equate with our limitations, and we fumble with our promises. With God, such a situation is incompatible with who He is. He is Almighty, who lacks nothing and there isn't any power in the universe that is beyond Him.

Our Lord is the architect of human history. He holds the blueprint of the future. He governs the entire creation both in heaven and on earth in absolute authority - Jesus said, "All power is given unto Me" (Matt 28:18). In the divine language, there is no vocabulary like error, blunder, or oversight. God's Word is living, active, and unchanging for eternity (Heb 4:12).

Brethren, how does this truth of God's immutability edify us as believers? The key word that comes to mind is stability. In our spiritual journey, we could experience extremity, harsh situations, rude shocks, depilating discouragements, and clueless sequels. If we are not careful, we become confused and unsettled in our walk with the Lord. Our discourses will be laced with murmurs and complaints. If you recall, even the birth of Christ was shrouded with challenging situations. The first Christmas was not surrounded by prompt and pageantry. The Lord's birth took place in a lowly manger. The Saviour's birth didn't summon a global celebration. Mary and Joseph had to escape from Jerusalem seeking refuge in Egypt for the child Jesus' safety. Despite the challenges. God's Word. His guidance, and promises canopied the whole Christmas scenario. Similarly, life may throw a curveball at us, but we focus on God's promises, confidently lean on His counsel, and remain assured that He is in absolute control and do life with confidence. In His time all will work out well (Rom 8:28).

Next, the very agenda for Christmas is not to call the chaotic world to order but to redeem man from his spiritual bankruptcy, delusion, and disorder. Praise God for the Christmas Musical "Kopitiam" attractively titled and cleverly choreographed to bring the Gospel to our unsaved loved ones and friends. The programme will follow with a sumptuous Christmas dinner. Let us enthusiastically invite many to the event. This is a very doable evangelistic outreach for the whole church.
