

Beauty Among The Ashes

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 28 January 2024

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Due to the Fall, we as followers of Christ are living in an imperfect and ugly sin-scarred world. We can also be influenced by negative emotions such as selfishness and anger, resulting in the chaos of our self-centered and self-righteous thoughts, actions, and decisions. At other times, we too experience the effects of the selfish actions of others.

Living in such an imperfect and ugly sin-scarred world can bring us frustration and disillusionment. Thus, we are always reminded to keep our focus instead on these 2 main aspects from Ps. 27:4 – 1) Beholding or looking intensely on the beauty of the LORD; and 2) Enquiring in His Temple.

First, to behold the beauty of the LORD does not appreciate His mean that we appearance and beauty like an art painting or sculpture as God is Spirit. Instead, it means to focus our attention on the qualities of God such as the grace of God (Eph. 2:8-9; 2 Cor. 12:9), the love of God (Eph. 2:4b-7), and the faithfulness of God (1 Cor. 12:13) to gain our confidence from them. This would surely help us rise from the ashes of our lives into the beautiful and joyous gift of our salvation (Isaiah 61:3 "To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified"). God indeed sees us as His blessed people whom He rewards with His everlasting covenant (Isaiah 63:8-9 "For I the Lord love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the Lord hath blessed").

Second, to enquire in the Temple means that we are not satisfied to just contemplatively reflect on God's qualities, but that our minds are active and inquisitive, and always desiring to dig deeper and deeper into God's Word. We do so to draw all the more nearer to Him (James 4:8a), and also have a greater knowledge and understanding of His ways and dealings in our lives (Isaiah 55:8-9).

The phrase "One thing have I desired of the Lord..." (Ps. 27:4a) reminds us to put walking with the LORD as our top priority. Our confidence in God and His Word would then protect us from the discouragement that comes with adversities in our lives.

We should also have the desire and determination in our hearts to "seek after" the LORD (Ps. 27:4b). Even when we are in dire and trying circumstances, we should still put our constant attention and focus on the LORD, as King David was in Ps. 63:1-2 when he was fleeing from his son Absalom and wandering in the wilderness.

God is surely always leading us, and we can find comfort and strength in His constant and neverfailing Presence (Ps. 27:4c "...that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life").

Let us draw our confidence, strength, and courage from the beautiful work of the LORD in our lives.
