### Pushing Forward! Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 7 January 2024

Brethren, New Year Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. By our good and gracious Lord, we have crossed over into a brand-new Year. Reflecting on the past year our hearts rapidly fill up with thanksgiving and praises come forth spontaneously; when realizing how undeserving we are of His bountiful blessings, humility bends our hearts in grateful worship. Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, our chief Shepherd, the Head of the Church has faithfully kept us and our church together and well. We render all glory to God our Father, Savior Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit who empowered us to do His Will and Work. Amen!

To do well in our faith and services to God, we must keep in mind the words of the Prophet Isaiah: "Remember ye, not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert." Isaiah 43:18-19. Our past year's good and bad experiences have tremendous influence and power to shape our perspectives, and model our values, hence dictate our decisions and directions for this year. Let us adhere to God's wise counsel.

<u>Remember Not</u>: In the past year we could have experienced unhappy moments in our family or church. We may have faltered in our work, service to God and decisions of which we are not proud of. We may have suffered undeserving harsh comments, insensitive treatments, or exasperating attempts to nudge one another in the service of the Lord. Yes, these experiences drain our energy, hurt our enthusiasm and even void our desire to do well in the Lord. The "Why-not-take-a-break" temptation is very real and attractive. Brethren, do not sign up for it hastily. God motivates His people to forget the former things and not to dwell on the past. How essentially a crucial reminder for us! We must not allow ourselves to be taken captive by the past. God liberated the people of Israel from Egypt, to move them to a greater life for His people according to His will and plan (Jere 29:11). Yes, they did not always fare well in their faith but God is gracious and never gave up on them. He graciously, patiently counselled and guided His chosen people. We need to respond to God's counsel as we should or else, we will lose out on God's complete plan for our lives and our church.

Brethren, the second half of the verse, "Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ve not know it?" creates great expectation in our hearts. Despite various challenges and concerns ahead of us, I am excited by God's Word that we can anticipate good new things in the New Year for us as a church to explore, contrive and realise for the edification of the saints and growth of the church. This new thing, new work, and new prospect have already begun from God's point of view. We need to pray for discernment to see His moving hands, sensitivity to His promptings, and leading of the Holy Spirit. So, God said to His people, "do you not see?" Sometimes we cannot see what God is doing when we busy ourselves with only what we see or what we want to see. The tension builds up, friction sparks off and we become blind to the Lord's leading. Remember, who is our Master and whose plan we are expected to work on? His will be done in 2024.

Lastly, the Lord alerts us to challenges and obstacles in our path—"wilderness and deserts." However, His promise to our church is, He will beat a path through the wilderness and even run rivers through the desert. We will not be lost nor suffer lack under His guidance. He will do Great and Mighty things that we know not (Jere 33:3). The challenges may be intense but His caring provision will more than match our headwinds.
