# **Giving Our All To God**

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 14 January 2024, Dedication Sunday

Blessed New Year greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We have just started this new year with our freshest and brightest hopes and aspirations in our minds. We also have a renewed and heightened level of energy and vigour that gives us the hope that we can go through and be sustained for the year ahead of us. But we are also mindful that possible challenges and difficulties and obstacles may lie in our paths and directions for this year.

How are we thus to approach this new year ahead of us? We are to have a balanced mixture of our humble dependence on God, and our human determination and resolution. Indeed, we are reminded that the sufficient strength to run our race here on Earth does not come merely from ourselves, but from God (Heb. 4:16 "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need"). When we are dependent on God, He alone is glorified (1 Cor. 1:30-31 "But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord').

When we determine in our hearts to give of our best to God, it shows to everyone around us of the first place He has in our lives. We would thus not hesitate to give Him our utmost time, resources. energy and commitment. But, other than all our doings for Him, we are not to neglect our relationship and love for Him (Matt. 22:37-38 "Jesus said unto him. Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment"). We should also not allow our love for God to be overshadowed by the other loves of the world (Matt. 6:24 "No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other: or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon"). Our love for God would then turn cold over time (Matt. 24:12 "And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold; Rev. 2:4 "Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love").

All our commitments, whether past, present or future, will surely form the entirety and direction of our lives. This fact further highlights the importance and the high degree of attention that we must pay to every commitment (personal, family, and societal) present in our lives. In addition, our character is formed by the nature of the commitments that we make at different junctions of our lives: Christlike or worldly (2 Peter 3:11 "Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ve to be in all holy conversation and godliness"). All of these should be covered by the scope of our honouring and serving our Almighty God and Heavenly Father (Joshua 24:15 "And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord").

As we commit and strive to give our all to serve our LORD, may we be encouraged and assured that He will strengthen our hearts and hands to do His Work (2 Chron. 16:9a "For the eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him..."). When we are weak (not proud) and willing to be dependent on the LORD, He will surely strengthen and uplift us to do His Work (2. Cor. 12:9-11).

May we all go forth with boldness and courage into this new year with the constant focus to carry out His Work for His praise and glory (Joshua 1:9 "Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the Lord thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest"). God bless!
