Early Church - Our Model!

Pastor Simon, Lord's Day, 18 February 2024

Brethren, Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! The Early Church was not perfect. Neither did the church exist in an easier or better world. The believers (like us today) were sinners saved by God's grace and the world was no less broken than it is today. The Early Church, despite her faults and weaknesses, operating in an unconducive and challenging environment was impressively faithful to God. The Book of Acts, chapters one and two, describes this small and growing fellowship of believers as a closely-knit community that prayed and worked together to bring the Gospel to the lost.

Firstly, the Church was a praying church. "These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication..." (Acts 1:14). Believers were committed to attending and participating in church prayer meetings regularly. Imagine now, If our church members attend our Wednesday and Sunday pre-worship prayer meetings, the extent of God's power we would experience and the distance we would go in His work. The unity of believers on bended knees blesses our Lord. Today, it is so much more possible and convenient compared to the pre-pandemic era. Now we do meetings online. In the convenience of our home, without hassle, we gather and pray!

They came with one mind, one purpose and a shared sense of need. One Hundred and twenty fervent believers, one body and spirit, joined in prayer and supplication for the promised blessings of God. A praying church is a spiritual church. Brethren, there is no substitute for prayer—prayer in the secrecy of one's closet, prayer in the family circle, and corporate prayer in the sanctuary of God's House. God delights in and blesses a praying church. May Galilee Church be a House of Prayer!

The Early Church was a witnessing church and God honours it. Acts 2:4 tells us: "They were all

filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak..." This verse does not say that the apostles began to speak or that the church leaders began to speak, but that "all" Christians spoke. The Early Church bore faithful witnesses for our Lord. What an exciting scene it must have been, a band of Christian witnesses excited and thrilled, proclaiming the life-saving Gospel to the startled people on the streets of Jerusalem: "He [Christ] is alive! He whom you killed arose from the grave! He is the Messiah, the fulfilment of Biblical prophecy! He is the Son of God and the loving Saviour of the world! He has redeemed us from our sins, and He can and will forgive you too if you trust Him and ask Him!"

Brethren, do we have such fire and drive in us? It is sad when the hinges on our prayer closets are rusty from neglect of use, our lips are unemployed, and our tongues are still. Are we content just to delegate our duty before God to "some" to pray and witness for us? Think of this... if every member of the church believes that prayer and witnessing are every Christian's privilege and joyful task, and does it faithfully, we will see a glorious Pentecost in our day, in our very church, here at Galilee it is possible!

Praise and thank God for the Lunar New Year steamboat gathering. Firstly, thank God for the organising team for their good and faithful work. Next, we thank the members, and friends for generous contributions in kind and cash. And all who worked before and after the programme to make this evening a special and meaningful one. We thank the Lord for Newcomers—friends and relatives of our members and regular worshippers. We pray they would have had a pleasant experience dining with our people in our church. We pray the shared Gospel, our kind gestures, will in God's good time cause a stir in their hearts and seek to know the Lord as their personal Saviour.
