Finding Our Rest In God Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 25 February 2024

Beloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Due to us living in a fast-paced and consumeristic Singapore, we are often caught up in our daily activities -- working, studying, having family time, and even serving the Lord in church. As a result, we find ourselves overwhelmed and stressed, and have no time to quieten ourselves and have proper rest.

Our experience of tiredness is both in the physical as well as the spiritual realms. Our physical bodies need their much-needed rest. Our weary souls also need their spiritual rest that can only be found in God (Matt. 11:28 "Come unto Me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest"). St. Augustine of Hippo prayed and sought rest in God: "You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our heart is restless until it rests in you." God Himself too rested on the seventh day after His six days of creation, setting for us a pattern to follow. Jesus Himself too intentionally sought to set aside time to rest and pray (Luke 5:16 "And He withdrew Himself into the wilderness, and prayed").

Let us thus understand that the Biblical concept of "rest" is more than mere physical rest and is very closely linked to having the inner peace of God in our hearts (Phil. 4:7 "And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus"). In addition, this inner rest and peace is also not just a mere one-time state or condition, but it should also be a continuous and ongoing process throughout our lives. However, it is not simply automatic, but it is needful for us to continually seek to cultivate this inner rest and peace. How are we then to find our rest in God? We are to spend time in communion with Him through prayer (Phil. 4:6), on His Word (Ps. 1:2-

3) and with His people (Heb. 10:24-25). All these spiritual disciplines will keep our hearts and minds focused on, and in tune with God.

Living in a fast-paced world would also mean that we can be stressed and pressed into making rushed decisions and according to our human understanding and perspective rather than God's. When our hearts are rested in God, we would then not see and respond to our struggles and difficulties with anger and frustration, but with the inner peace from God. We would then be renewed and recharged by God to deal with our life circumstances and rise above them (Isaiah 40:31 "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint").

Heb. 12:2 urges us to put aside every weight and the sin in our lives so that we can walk well with God. This "every weight" is not necessarily sinful. It could refer to something neutral such as the demands of our family, our work or career, studies, and our relationships or friendships that can hinder or stumble us from fulfilling God's Will in our lives. The phrase "the sin" also warns us of the effect of harbouring and perpetuating specific sins that will stunt our spiritual effectiveness for God.

Brethren, let us slow the pace in our hectic schedules, and make time and space to find our perfect rest in God. Let us offer our lives as living sacrifices, pleasing and acceptable to God, and we will not burn out easily in our passion and zeal in service for Him (Romans 12:1; 2 Tim. 1:6).
