rethren. Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Indeed, we have all tasted the goodness of the Lord (Psalm 34:8) in the yesteryear. With a whole new year ahead of us, how do we plan to do well in our walk with our Lord, to make our lives count for Him, and to be a blessing to one another? In slightly less than a week, our precious families will gather for the Lunar New Year's Eve Reunion Dinner to reioice over the goodness, mercies and blessings of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, and enjoy a sumptuous meal together. An invaluable tradition that strengthens family bonds, diffuses differences, permits the opportunity to forgo unpleasant experiences and the exchange of well wishes fades out frictions from the past.

The Apostle Paul's excellent prayer for the believers in Colosse is most apt and befitting as we start on this Lunar New Year.... "...that ye might be filled with the knowledge of His [God's] Will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God" (Colossians 1:9-10). It starts with an ever-growing deeper relationship with God, ever-increasing in wisdom, knowledge and understanding of God and His Will for our lives.

Firstly, and so importantly, Paul prayed that the Colossian brethren would know the Will of God. He could have prayed that they would not be persecuted, that they would have good health, or that they would prosper... and the like, but no, Paul prayed that the brethren would know God's Perfect Will for their lives. Paul was spot on! Brethren, what good is it for a person to have health, to own mansions, to sit in high positions of power... if he does not have Christ, and know not the Will of God for his life? "Success", if one may call it, for the Christian, starts with being in a loving and trusting relationship with God, abiding in His Sovereign Will.

and acknowledging that God is the Source of knowledge and wisdom. This is true blessedness! For us parents, what is more important is the next generation would love God and live their lives for Christ. Only spiritual legacy will stand for time and eternity. We all have high aspirations for our beloved children but, more than anything else, parents' hearts desire that their children love God, serve Him, and keep a close walk with God from young. When God is honoured, everything in life will fall nicely into place. "We know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose" (Romans 8:28).

Paul prayed that the Colossians would receive the Word of God "in all wisdom and spiritual understanding." It is important that we "develop the mind of Christ" through His Word and see all things from His perspective. The Christian must cultivate spiritual disciplines and the ability to discern, through God's Word and the guidance of the Holy Spirit -- what is right and wrong, and what is good and bad -- and to do what Jesus would want us to do. Yes, worldly counsel may seem rational and reasonable, but Christians cannot conform to do anything contrary to what God teaches us in His Word. Brethren, the Bible is God's "road map" for the Christian for therein contains the whole counsel of God -- good for every circumstance of life.

Next, a Christian's life must have Kingdom value and bear much fruit for God. Let's pray God for grace, strength and wisdom to live a year of everincreasing love for God, a year to get to know Him deeper, a year of greater understanding of His Word, a year of abiding in Jesus as our Vine, a year of spurring one another unto greater heights of love and good works for Christ, a year joyful in worship, fruitful in service, and faithful in serving the Lord, a year more of Christ and less of self. Amen.
