## FINDING OUR BLESSEDNESS IN CHRIST

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 11 February 2024

eloved Brethren, Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. During this Chinese New Year season, the word "blessedness" should very immediately and naturally come to our minds. But how do we understand and view the word "blessedness"? Is it merely the physical or material blessings that we receive and enjoy them? From Luke 12:21 "So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God", we are warned against having a mere materialistic view or angle of "blessedness". We are to instead holistic understanding have "blessedness" which besides the physical or material, also includes the much more important spiritual aspect (Eph. "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ").

There is indeed a myriad of worldly things that constantly attract and tempt us (1 John 2:16 "For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world"). To counteract them, let us remember the bounteous love and care that God has for each of us (Eph. 1:4 "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love"). We also have the comforting assurance that we have been chosen by God according to His Will and thus are empowered and enabled to live lives as children of His kingdom (Eph. 1:5 "Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His

Will"). Knowing these, we would have the spiritual strength to walk as children of light (Eph. 5:8), and not remain in the darkness of disobedience and subject to God's wrath (Eph. 2:2-3).

We are to be mindful that our blessings are not merely gained and obtained by our strength and wisdom but have been given to us by God Himself (James 1:17 "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning"). It is also indeed our blessed relationship with Christ that keeps us going in all seasons of our lives (Eph. 1:3 "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ"). goodness will surely shine through even the deepest darkness and gloom of our lives.

We are to be grateful and praise God that He has blessed us and will continue to bless us (Eph. 1:6 "To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved"). May we realise that our greatest joy and satisfaction can only be found in Him and not any other (Ps. 42:1-2 "As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God. My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God?").

Let us also share His blessings with others so that we would not become too self-absorbed, and will see it as an important part of our Christian witness to the people around us (Matt. 5:13-16).
