On Mission For God

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 24 March 2024

Beloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Have you ever wondered at any stage of your life why and for what purpose you are living for on this Earth? And have any feelings of frustration and hopelessness overwhelmed you at the lack of achievements and accomplishments in your life?

It is indeed a very good and timely reminder that God fulfils His purposes and has His reasons for every single thing, whether significant or insignificant in our human eyes and understanding, that takes place in our lives (Ps. 57:2 "I will cry unto God most high; unto God that performeth all things for me"). But we should move on to reflecting and thinking about what is the one overarching purpose or aim that God wants each of us to fulfil for Him?

We are all to move and do according to being on mission for God. Being on mission for God means that we are joining or partnering Him in His Work of saving souls and making disciples in this world. This means that mission work is not only limited to the role of mission trips but also to how we maximise our relational and social circles for the kingdom of God. We are placed His ambassadors reconciling and bringing people back into a right relationship with Him (2 Cor. 5:18-20). This is surely not an easy and smooth task as the focus of people's minds are on themselves and thinking that they have no need for God. It is also easy for us, His followers to lose sight of God and His works amid the busyness and what seems to attract us in this world.

Let us align our hearts to that of God's as His

heart is surely that of His strong and great love for all peoples (John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life"; Romans 5:8 "But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us"). When we have this same love and concern for all people, whether in the different communities in our home city of Singapore or in other nations, we would be moved by God to be His instruments to bring the Gospel to others (Matt. 4:19 "And He [Jesus] saith unto them, Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men").

When we engage in God's mission, it does not mean that it is always smooth and without its difficulties. We are reminded that even with our best efforts, it is only through God's strength and His mighty work that it can be done (Matt. 28:18, 20b "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth... and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen"). But what remains is that our hearts are willing and open toward what God wants us to do for His Kingdom purposes whether in church and in society or community (Matt. 6:33a "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness..."). Let us thus see our priority of using our gifts, talents and strengths to be used in the church, and then also effectively use them in society for His praise and glory.

Brethren, let us be committed to always live with God's Kingdom and His purposes in mind. When we do so, we would be prepared to serve Him as our ongoing act of worship (Rom. 12:1).
