Christ Is Risen!





rethren. Greetings in the Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! In our world, numerous things have risen. The temperature around the world has risen. Consequently, the sea level has risen and rising. Forest fire incidences have risen. Another phenomenon has arisen. new complications in childbearing. This year, researchers in India discovered that working in extreme heat can double the risk of stillbirth and miscarriage for pregnant women, due to hotter summers. Wars had risen! The ongoing wars in the Middle East and Europe daily escalate the number of deaths and suffering. Natural disasters had risen. Diseases that were once thought eliminated have risen again. With the combination of these various conditions, inflation has risen. Tension and anxiety have risen around the world with the pending America's Presidential Elections. At this point. concerns for our tomorrow have risen. Yes, only natural, isn't it? When reasonable hope and dreams fade in and out. Ambitions and aspirations fluctuate insanely. What kind of future does this world promise to offer us, and the coming generations?

ALL PRAISE TO GOD: CHRIST IS RISEN! This day makes all the difference. Paul is right in saying, "If only in this life we are having hope in Christ, we are more to be pitied than all men" 1 Cor 15:19. The resurrection of the Lord, dispels all darkness, gloom, and grimness this world affords in its broken state. Easter saves us from the penalty of sins, and restores hope, and purpose for our lives. Two thousand years ago, our Saviour Jesus Christ, rose from the dead victoriously. He conquered death and defused the curse of sin-death. Paul writes. "O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" 1 Cor 15:55-57.

The world is not going to get better, instead, according to God's Word, will only spiral faster and further into its worst possible state. However, we can walk confidently despite living in an extremely

uncertain and troubled world. All praise to God!

Let us refresh our minds on the actual situation on Easter morning. The narrative according to Matt 28:5-7, "And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified. He is not here: for He is risen... go quickly, and tell His disciples that **He is risen from the dead;**"

Like in the birth of Christ, angels proclaimed the Good News. Likewise, an angel informs the visitors of the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Easter is not a church-manufactured program. It is a heavenly event that took place in our broken world. All prophesies in the Bible gravitated towards this day promising eternal life to all who would put their faith in Him. Without the Lord's resurrection, we would remain in our sin and perish in it (1 Cor 15:17).

The first word of assurance from God's messenger was "fear not." Imagine the mental and emotional state of these women whose world collapsed a few days ago with our Lord's death. They plunged into profound sorrow and inconsolable mourning when they lost their Jesus to the cruel spiritual and political authorities of their time. They were weak and utterly helpless! They witnessed how the Lord was shamed, humiliated, and suffered despite His innocence. He was falsely accused, heartlessly ridiculed, brutally treated, and cruelly nailed to the cross to suffer and die an excruciating death. Let us take note, our Christ lived in our fallen world. He is no stranger to suffering, pain and harsh conditions. Despite the uncomely situations prevailing in our close guarters or globally, we need not fear, we have a Saviour whom we can count on.

The Lord's resurrection is not supposed to be personal or state secret but an all-important Good News to be proclaimed to all people. Easter is a victorious Gospel message to lost mankind. We need to rise and shout at our rooftops that **Christ has Risen!** We have hope here and beyond ONLY in Him. Hallelujah! Praise the Lord!
