

# Our Life-Mission

*Pastor Freddy Yong, Lord's Day, 3 March 2024*

**B**rethren,  
"Ye are the light of the world...Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven" (Matt. 5:14,16). This verse begins immediately after the Beatitudes – it means that after all the life blessedness, you're to be light of the world. You're to shine for Christ because you're blessed with all the spiritual blessing and ready to shine forth for your new Master. Why we need to shine?

Just by taking one look at the news, you can see horrifying anger, crime, terror, and disease. Politics is dark. Entertainment is dark. Social media is dark. And with all this going on around us, we can be tempted to shake our fists at God and cry, "Where are you in all this darkness? We need light!" If we did so, God would likely grip our shoulders, look us in the eye and say, "You are the light." You suppose to shine for Jesus!

In the darkness of crime, terror, and disease, we are the light. In the darkness of modern politics, entertainment, and social media, we are the light. It's not that we ought to be the light. It's that we are the light. And we are meant to shine by doing good works that glorify God.

In contrast to the life of a pseudo-Christian who is like salt without the savour, he has no vital connection with God, and like the worthless salt, which Christ describes as being good for nothing but to be cast out and trodden under foot of men – his life is as bland as the tasteless water. Thus is the life of a so-called follower of Christ who is not living a life connected with Jesus Christ. He can't be a light shining in the darkness of life. They see nothing to praise God for.

How can I be the true light? Christians shine with their good works, with their cheerfulness and

courage. Indeed, be the light of the world for Christ!

We shine for Christ when we become light in our daily lives. Here is a story on how one become a light: "Early on a Sunday morning, I stopped by a gas station on my way to a speaking engagement at a church. A man named Greg approached my car and asked if I could give him a ride in the opposite direction. My first instinct was to say "no" because it was inconvenient. However, I had an open door right in front of me to be a light in his life.

Greg jumped into my car, and I drove him to where he wanted to go. Before he got out of the car, he started to open to me. I remember him saying that no one would help him and how amazed he was that I opened my door to drive him home. This simple act of love was life-changing for me because I never realized something so simple could speak so loudly to someone.

A few months later, I was booked to speak at another church. Before the service started, a man came up behind me and said, "Hey Mike, do you remember me?"

Truthfully, I couldn't remember who this man was if my life depended on it. He said, "It's Greg. You picked me up a few months ago." He then said, "I literally thought you were an angel," which is when I responded by saying, "Sorry to disappoint you." Greg and I chatted for a while, and he talked about how that night completely changed his life. Now he is attending church and about to get baptized. A simple act of love pointing to Jesus changed this man's life, and all I really did was open the car door and brought up Jesus in our conversation."

Are you connected with Jesus? Are you constantly shining for Jesus?
