


"You have a Calling!"

Finding Our Focus In Christ

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 10 March 2024

eloved Brethren,
Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
Living in an industrialised, fast-paced and consumeristic world, we face many temptations and choices of which some give us feel-good highs and instant gratifications. How are we then to make the right choice from among the myriad and confusing choices that we face at the many junctions we come across?

The single focus, that we should have in our lives such that we can be confident that we are walking and heading in the right direction, is indeed Jesus Himself (Heb. 12:2 "Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God"). It is not merely our intellectual and head knowledge, but our relationship with Him that comforts and reassures us of His constant presence.

Firstly, God has given us His Holy Word, the Bible, to keep us along the right path (Ps. 119:105 "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path". It is surely through our humility and submission to His Word that our whole character would indeed be moulded and shaped more and more into His image (2 Tim. 3:16-17 "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works"). We should thus not base the standard of our living on any other.

Secondly, we have the Blessed Holy Spirit to remind and guide us in God's ways (John 14:26 "But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My

Name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you"). It is important that we are sensitive and responsive to the Holy Spirit when He prompts us of our wrongdoings and redirects us to the right path (Gal. 5:16 "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh").

Thirdly, we need to have accountability partners, most likely in our SSGs (Small Support Groups), to encourage and keep one another updated and accountable in our spiritual walk with God. This is especially important as we are living in the Last Days and can easily be led astray by the deceitfulness of sin (Heb. 3:13 "But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin"). We should not think that we are able to stand alone, and we need to walk together in standing strong in God.

When we fix our focus on Christ, our values and priorities would be toward the spiritual, rather than the earthly (Col. 3:2 "Set your affection [minds] on things above, not on things on the earth"), and our decisions and directions will reflect Christ and bring glory to His Holy Name. When we draw our strength from Christ, we will be empowered by Him especially amid the trials and difficulties that confront us (Rom. 8:18 "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us").

Brethren, let us commit to live, God helping us, with our vision on the Cross at Calvary, always focused and fixed on Christ, our Rock, our Strength, our Blessed Redeemer. Amen.
