## Willing To Be Used By God

Preacher David Cher, Lord's Day, 28 April 2024

eloved Brethren. Greetings in the Precious Name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Have you allowed the successes achievements in your life experiences to cloud and fill your mind with pride and self-sufficiency? When we are tempted to take up a high and lofted position, we are reminded from Prov. 16:18 "Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall".

How then are we to conduct ourselves in this pragmatic, success-driven and image-conscious world? We are certainly not to hold tightly and form our identify based on what the world values highly such as wealth, high social standing, and power (1 Cor. 4:10 "We are fools for Christ's sake, but ye are wise in Christ; we are weak, but ye are strong; ye are honourable, but we are despised"). When we do so, we would realise that our sufficiency and dependency are on Christ and His grace and strength rather than ourselves (2 Cor. 12:9-10 "9 But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong").

This means that God does not look only at the rich, intelligent and powerful, but also ordinary people like us to do extraordinary things for Him. We look at King David who grew up as a shepherd boy, and the 12 disciples who came from diverse humble occupations such as fishermen, tradesmen, craftsmen, or farmers, a tax collector, and a Zealot [belonging to a group with politically radical views and actions toward God bless!

opposing and overthrowing the then ruling Roman government]. Thus, we should not downplay our significance in doing our part in the Lord's service such as how Jesus used the relatively small number of loaves and fishes for His Work. What is more important is our heart of availability and faithfulness toward His service (Rom. 12:1 "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God-this is your true and proper worship [or your spiritual servicel").

As we humble and place ourselves under the mighty Hand of God, we acknowledge that His plans and purposes have certainly taken over the direction of our lives (Luke 9:23-24 "23 Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will save it"). The image of the cross also gives us the important message that even as we follow Christ, there will be weights and difficulties along this same path that we take. But we are not meant to take our burdens or loads by ourselves. but by His love and strength (Ps. 55:22 "Cast your cares on the Lord and He will sustain you: He will never let the righteous be shaken"). And our muscles of faith would also grow and be strengthened in the process too.

Eph. 3:20-21 "Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen."
